### EDGAR CONFERENCE SCHEDULED

The Commission has scheduled an EDGAR Conference for Tuesday, November 10, 1998.

Hours: 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Site: The Department of Agriculture's Jefferson Auditorium located in the South Building at 14th Street and Independence Avenue, S.W., Washington, D.C.

Topics: SEC staff will discuss the current status of EDGAR and the EDGAR modernization effort, known as EDGAR II.

Auditorium:

If you have registered for the conference by November 6, enter the facility by the Wing 5 entrance (on the Independence Avenue side of the building, near 14th Street).

The Wing 1 entrance is handicapped accessible.

ID's  
Required:

To be admitted, you must bring a picture ID issued by a federal or state agency, such as a driver's license. Work ID's will not be accepted.

Security  
Procedures:

All conference participants must pass through a metal detector. Please allow extra time for this procedure.

Arrival  
Times:

You will be able to enter the Jefferson Auditorium, located approximately 30 yards to the right of Wing 5 entrance at 8:00 a.m. If you arrive earlier than 8:00 a.m., you may visit the Department of Agriculture Cafeteria, located in Wing 3 of the facility.

Personal  
Equipment:

We recommend that you do not bring computer equipment, tape recorders, or portable telephones with you to the conference. If you do, you MUST register this equipment when you enter the Department of Agriculture Building by giving the guards the serial number, make, and model of the equipment and your name, your company name, and your Social Security number. This information will be used to authenticate ownership of the equipment when you leave the building. Please note that all briefcases and large bags will be searched upon leaving the facility.

Solicitation  
Not Permitted:

No solicitation of any kind is permitted in this government building. For example, filing agents and training agents may not leave brochures describing their services on the registration desk or on the chairs of those attending the conference, nor may they give this information to conference attendees entering or leaving the Jefferson Auditorium.

**FEE RATE ADVISORY**

We expect the continuing resolution (CR) the Securities and Exchange Commission has been funded under since October 1, 1998, to be extended until midnight Wednesday, October 21. At this time we cannot be certain what the fee rate will be for filings on Thursday, October 22. The three possibilities are:

- 1) If the pending appropriations bill is enacted, the fee rate will decrease to \$278 per \$1,000,000. This rate also must be applied pro rata to amounts less than \$1,000,000. The fee should be calculated by multiplying the aggregate offering amount by .000278.
- 2) If the CR is extended beyond Wednesday night, the fee rate on filings made pursuant to Section 6(b) of the Securities Act of 1933 will continue at the current rate of \$295 per \$1,000,000. This fee should be applied pro rata to amounts less than \$1,000,000 and should be calculated by multiplying the aggregate offering amount by .000295.
- 3) If the CR is not extended and there is a funding gap, the fee rate on filings made pursuant to Section 6(b) of the Securities Act of 1933 will continue at the current rate of \$295 per \$1,000,000. This fee should be applied pro rata to amounts less than \$1,000,000 and should be calculated by multiplying the aggregate offering amount by .000295.

The Commission will issue further notices as appropriate to keep filers and registrants informed of developments affecting the Section 6(b) fee rate. **ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS**

**ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS SETTLED AGAINST DAVID D'ANDREA**

On October 20, the Commission settled administrative proceedings against David W. D'Andrea (D'Andrea) of Babylon, New York. Previously, on June 3, 1998, the Commission entered an order instituting proceedings (Order) against D'Andrea based on his March 26, 1997, conviction for conspiracy to commit securities fraud, mail fraud and wire fraud (U.S. v. D'Andrea, Case No. 96-6143-CR-GONZALEZ, S.D. Fla. 1997). The Commission's Order alleged that

while associated with the Boca Raton office of Barron Chase Securities, Inc., D'Andrea accepted approximately \$10,000 in undisclosed commissions from a stock promoter for inducing his clients to purchase certain securities. In his Offer of Settlement, D'Andrea agreed to an Order barring him from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company. ## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

---

### THE WHITE ELK FUNDS, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting The White Elk Funds (Funds) and White Elk Asset Management, Inc. (Adviser) from the provisions of Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a) and 15(b) of the Act, and Rules 6e-2(b)(15) and 6e-3(T)(b)(15) thereunder, to permit shares of certain series of the Funds and shares of any other investment company that is designed to fund insurance products and for which the Adviser or any of its affiliates may serve as investment adviser, administrator, manager, principal underwriter, or sponsor to be sold to and held by: (1) separate accounts funding variable annuity and variable life insurance contracts of both affiliated and unaffiliated life insurance companies; and (2) qualified pension and retirement plans. ## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change submitted by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-98-64) relating to extending the arbitrator list selection method to disputes involving members and associated persons. (Rel. 34-40556)

### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-98-26) to provide for a closing rotation in Exchange-traded options on the last trading day of each calendar quarter. (Rel. 34-40564)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change and issued notice of filing and granted accelerated approval to Amendment No. 1 thereto submitted under Section 19(b)(1) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-98-30) to reduce the value of the National Over-the-Counter Index to one-quarter of its present value. The Index is a capitalization-weighted market

index composed of the 100 largest capitalized stocks traded over-the-counter. Publication of the approval order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of October 19. (Rel. 34-40565)

#### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change (SR-NASD-98-76) filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers relating to standards for individual correspondence has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of October 19. (Rel. 34-40570)
