COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

STEPHEN CUTLER NAMED DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT

On November 18, Chairman Arthur Levitt named Stephen M. Cutler Deputy Director of the Division of Enforcement. Mr. Cutler, who will join the Commission shortly, succeeds Colleen Mahoney, who left the Commission in July.

Mr. Cutler, 37, has been a partner at the Washington, D.C. law firm of Wilmer, Cutler & Pickering since 1993. He specializes in securities enforcement and litigation, as well as broker-dealer regulation and compliance. Before becoming a partner, he was an associate at the firm from 1987 to 1992. Mr. Cutler was a visiting fellow at the Center for Law in the Public Interest from 1986 to 1987, and before that was a law clerk for the Honorable Dorothy W. Nelson of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit. He received his B.A. summa cum laude from Yale University and his J.D. from Yale Law School, where he was editor of the Yale Law Journal. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

COMMISSION SANCTIONS VALICENTI ADVISORY SERVICES, INC. AND VINCENT VALICENTI

The Commission has imposed sanctions on Valicenti Advisory Services, Inc. (VAS), a registered investment adviser located in Elmira, New York, and Vincent R. Valicenti, its president. VAS was fined \$50,000 and Valicenti \$25,000. In addition, respondents were censured, ordered to cease and desist from further violations of antifraud provisions, and required to send a copy of the Commission's opinion and order to all existing clients and, for one year, to all prospective clients.

The Commission found that, in 1992, respondents distributed two pieces of misleading sales literature to prospective clients. The Commission stated that the literature presented a false portrayal of VAS's past performance and a misleading comparison of that performance with the performance of other money managers. (Rel. FINANCIAL OPERATIONS PRINCIPAL AND ASSISTANT CHARGED IN MASSIVE EQUIPMENT LEASE PONZI SCHEME AND BOND MISAPPROPRIATION FRAUD

The Commission announced that it filed a complaint today charging Anthony Gianninoto and Eileen Laine for their roles in the widespread Ponzi scheme that was perpetrated until March 1997 by First Interregional Equity Corporation (FIEC), First Interregional Advisors Corporation (FIAC) and certain associated individuals. This is the second Commission action arising out of the FIEC/FIAC scheme, in which approximately 1700 investors were defrauded out of at least \$100 million. Gianninoto (age 50) served as FIEC's financial operations principal and FIAC's vice president, treasurer and secretary. Laine (age 46) was a data processing manager for FIEC and worked in a similar capacity for FIAC. The complaint alleges that Gianninoto and Laine were directly involved in two schemes: offering and selling investors assignments to equipment leases that already had been sold to other investors; and misappropriating bonds from the accounts of FIEC customers. Gianninoto and Laine respectively supervised, and worked in, FIAC's and FIEC's back office. In those roles, among other things, they created and sent investors materially misleading documents concerning the equipment leases; created and sent investors falsified monthly customer statements; worked to divert proceeds from the fraudulent sale of equipment leases to the ultimate use of FIEC and certain of its principals; and falsified and altered securities records, ledgers, and other documents to effectuate and conceal the misappropriation of bonds from customer accounts. During the relevant times, Gianninoto and Laine knew that FIAC and FIEC were defrauding investors in the equipment leases and misappropriating customer securities.

The complaint alleges that Gianninoto and Laine violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The complaint further alleges that, pursuant to Section 20(f) of the Exchange Act, Gianninoto and Laine are liable for aiding and abetting books and records violations of FIEC under Section 17(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 17a-3 and 17a-11 thereunder. The Commission seeks a Final Judgment against Gianninoto and Laine enjoining them from future violations of the above-cited provisions; ordering them to disgorge of all of their ill-gotten gains, plus prejudgment interest; directing to provide verified accountings; and assessing civil penalties against them. A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 14, 1998, to request a hearing on an application by INVESCO Value Trust for an order under Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Act. The order would permit an in-kind redemption of shares of the applicant by an affiliated person of the applicant. (Rel. IC-23540 - November 18)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing New England Electric System, a registered holding company, to issue, through December 31, 2002, an additional one million shares of its common stock to acquire "energy-related companies," as defined in Rule 58 under the Act. (Rel. 35-26942)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE
