ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

STEVEN BROADBENT, C.P.A., DENIED THE PRIVILEGE OF APPEARING OR PRACTICING BEFORE THE COMMISSION PURSUANT TO RULE 102(e)

On June 3, the Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings and Opinion and Order Pursuant to Rule 102(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice against Steven F. Broadbent (Broadbent) of Washington, Missouri, a certified public accountant currently licensed by the State of Missouri who conducted audits of Greenway Environmental Services, Inc. (Greenway), a Nevada corporation headquartered in Gilbert, Arizona, when he was an Arizona-licensed C.P.A. and practiced with the firm of Broadbent, Law & Co., P.C. The Order permanently denies Broadbent the privilege of appearing or practicing before the Commission as an accountant. Broadbent consented to the issuance of the Order without admitting or denying the findings contained in it, except the finding that he was permanently enjoined from violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act).

The Commission imposed this sanction and made its findings on the basis of a permanent injunction entered against Broadbent, by consent, on May 20, 1997, by the Honorable Emmet G. Sullivan of the United States District Court for the District of Columbia, enjoining Broadbent from violating the antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act. Broadbent neither admitted nor denied the allegations contained in the Commission's complaint filed in the civil action.

The complaint alleges that Broadbent, then an Arizona-licensed certified public accountant, prepared fraudulent financial statements contained in periodic reports filed by Greenway when he knew or was reckless in not knowing that they materially overstated Greenway's assets and included assets Greenway did not own. The complaint further alleges that Broadbent certified the financial statements when he knew or was reckless in not knowing that he had not audited them in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. In addition, the complaint alleges that Broadbent held himself out as Greenway's independent auditor in connection with Greenway's year-end 1991 and 1992 audited financial statements when he, in fact, lacked the independence required because he had prepared the financial statements he was auditing and had performed

COMMISSION SUES PANWORLD MINERALS INTERNATIONAL, INC. AND OTHERS

The Commission filed a complaint in United States District Court for Utah seeking permanent injunctions against PanWorld, Robert Weeks, Kenneth Weeks, David Hesterman, of Salt Lake, Utah, Larry Krasny and L.K. Management, Inc., of Los Angeles, California, Joseph Fabiilli and Puritan Communications, Inc., of New York, New York, Jerome Wenger of Bethesda, Maryland, and Randall Gilbert of Evans, Georgia. The complaint alleges from 1989 through 1995, PanWorld, Weeks, Ken Weeks and Hesterman prepared false periodic reports and promotional materials inflating the value of PanWorld's mineral properties, misrepresenting business operations, and projecting huge revenues and earnings. They hired "consultants," L.K. Management, Krasny, Puritan, Fabiilli, and Wenger, to tout PanWorld stock and manipulate the market, who failed to disclose receipt of millions of PanWorld shares and sales of those shares while they recommended PanWorld to investors. Gilbert bought shares and held them off the market to reduce the supply as part of the manipulation. The defendants distributed unregistered stock abusing the provisions of Form S-8 and Regulation S, and obtaining over \$9.4 million from investors. The complaint alleges violations of Sections 5(a), 5(c), 17(a), 17(b) of the Securities Act and Sections 10(b), 13(a), 15(a), 15(d) of the Exchange Act and various rules. [SEC v. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE BSC EMPLOYEE FUND, L.P. AND BSCGP INC.

An order has been issued on an application filed by The BSC Employee Fund, L.P. (Partnership) and BSCGP Inc. under Section 6(b) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from all provisions of the Act except Sections 7, 8(a), 9, 17 (except for certain provisions of Section 17(a), (d), (f), (g), and (j)), and 36 through 53, and the rules and regulations thereunder. The order would permit the Partnership, and other partnerships offered to the same class of investors, to engage in certain affiliated and joint transactions. Each partnership will be an employees' securities company within the meaning of Section 2(a)(13) of the Act. Partnership interests will be offered to eligible employees, officers, and directors of The Bear Stearns Companies Inc. (BSC) and any entities controlled directly or indirectly by BSC. (Rel. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE AND TEMPORARY ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval on a temporary basis to a proposed rule change submitted by the Chicago Stock Exchange (SR-CHX-97-11) to reduce its minimum trading variation to 1/16 of a dollar for securities traded both on the Exchange and on the Nasdaq National Market that are selling at or greater than \$10.00 and to 1/32 of \$1.00 for such securities that are selling below \$10.00. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 2. (Rel. 34-38704)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Options Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-97-02) to permit the issuance, clearance, and settlement of options on certain interests in unit investment trusts and shares in investment companies that hold baskets or portfolios of common stock. (Rel. 34-38706)
