ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

COMMISSION DISMISSES APPEAL OF JJFN SERVICES, INC. FROM DENIAL OF NASDAQ INCLUSION

On November 21, the Commission has dismissed the appeal of JJFN Services, Inc. (JJFN) from the decision of the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (NASD) denying JJFN's application for inclusion of its securities in the Nasdaq SmallCap Market.

JJFN is a Delaware corporation organized in 1995 and engaged in the purchase and leaseback of model homes. David Miller, a control person of JJFN, pleaded guilty in 1992 to three felony tax fraud charges. The NASD denied JJFN's application for inclusion in Nasdaq on the grounds that JJFN is "dependent on" Miller, that he is "essential" to JJFN, and that Miller's conviction for tax fraud indicates a propensity to engage in conduct detrimental to public investors.

The Commission found that a factual basis exists to deny JJFN's application for inclusion of its securities in the Nasdaq SmallCap Market; that the NASD acted with respect to JJFN in accordance with its rules; that the NASD's rules are, and were applied in a manner, consistent with the purposes of the securities laws; and that the NASD's denial of JJFN's application for inclusion did not impose an unnecessary or inappropriate burden on competition. In doing so, the Commission found that Miller's tax fraud conviction legitimately may be considered as evidence of a propensity for future conduct violative of securities laws or regulations. The tax and the securities regulatory schemes both depend on the honor, candor, and integrity of regulated persons to report information truthfully. (Rel. 34-39343; File No. 3-9229)

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AND EMERGENCY RELIEF GRANTED IN ACTION INVOLVING SALE OF FICTITIOUS CERTIFICATES OF DEPOSIT AND JAPANESE TREASURY BONDS

The Commission announced today that on November 21 it filed a complaint and obtained emergency relief in an action involving the offer to sell forged and fictitious certificates of deposits (CDs) purportedly issued by an Argentinean bank and treasury bonds purportedly issued by the government of Japan. Judge Charles

Brieant issued a temporary restraining order and other relief against Uniglobe Trading Company Inc. (Uniglobe), a Yonkers, New York entity which claims to assist clients in the transfer of financial instruments and commodities; two of its officers, Clint Holland (Holland) and Margaret Laughrin (Laughrin); Moorgreen Holdings Limited (Moorgreen), a Gibraltar company with offices in Spain; and a Moorgreen representative, Raymond Nakachian (Nakachian). The Commission alleged that since at least October 1997, the defendants have been engaging in an apparent scheme to defraud U.S. investors through the offer of fraudulent securities in violation of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws.

The complaint alleged that the defendants have offered for sale at least two, and possibly as many as sixteen, fraudulent certificates of deposit (CDs) of Banco de la Nacion Argentina with stated principal amounts exceeding [U.S.] \$100 million each. The defendants offered the CDs, due to mature in approximately one year, at substantial discounts from face value, in cash only transactions. The Commission alleged that during the same time period, Uniglobe, Holland and Laughrin also offered for sale approximately 24 treasury bonds purportedly issued by the Japanese government each in dominations of \$500 million yen [approximately U.S. \$4.2 million]. The Commission, citing evidence from the Argentinean bank and Japanese government, alleged that the instruments are fraudulent.

To prevent Uniglobe, Laughrin, Holland, Moorgreen and Nakachian from continuing to offer these and other securities and potentially selling them to investors, the Commission requested the relief granted by Judge Brieant including a temporary restraining order, an order freezing the CDs and bonds, and an order that the defendants tender the instruments to the registry of the Court. Further, the Judge's order requires an accounting from the defendants of all assets, including certificates of deposit, financial instruments or government bonds, held by the defendants or offered by the defendants for sale or other transfer. CIVIL INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST STEVEN STRAUSS

On November 21, the Commission filed a civil injunctive action for fraud against Steven Strauss, a former managing director of Sakura Global Capital, Inc. (Sakura), for his conduct in two 1992 municipal bond transactions underwritten by Stifel, Nicolaus & Company, Inc. (Stifel). In a transaction for the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority in which Sakura provided a forward purchase agreement (forward), the complaint alleges that Sakura, through Strauss, made a \$6.593 million payment to Stifel, and that the payment jeopardized the tax-exempt status of the bonds. However, the complaint alleges that the forward, which Strauss signed on behalf of Sakura, stated that Sakura did not intend to take any actions which would jeopardize the tax-exempt status of the bonds. In a transaction for the Sisters of St. Mary's Health Care Obligated Group, in which Sakura provided a forward, the complaint alleges that despite Strauss' certification

that Sakura would not make any payments, other than certain payments to the issuer, in connection with the forward, Strauss caused Sakura to make a \$100,000 payment to Stifel. The complaint alleges that this payment jeopardized the tax-exempt status of the bonds.

The complaint alleges that by his conduct, Strauss violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The complaint seeks relief including a permanent injunction barring Strauss from future violations of those provisions and the imposition of a civil penalty. [SEC v. Steven Strauss, Civ. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BANK AUSTRIA AG AND BANK AUSTRIA MORTGAGE CORP.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 16, 1997 to request a hearing on an application filed by Bank Austria AG (Bank Austria) and Bank Austria Mortgage Corp. (Mortgage Corp.) for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Mortgage Corp. from all provisions of the Act. The order would permit Mortgage Corp., a real estate investment trust, to hold certain real estate related assets of Bank Austria. (Rel. IC-22899 - November 20)

FIRST AMERICAN INVESTMENT FUNDS, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by First American Investment Funds, Inc., et al. under Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act granting relief from Section 17(a). The order permits certain series of three registered open-end investment companies to acquire all of the assets and liabilities of the series of another registered open-end investment company. (Rel.
