NRC ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON REACTOR SAFEGUARDS TO MEET NOV. 6-8 IN ROCKVILLE, MD.

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (ACRS) will hold a public meeting November 6-8 in Rockville, Md., to discuss several issues of current interest including briefing by representatives of the NRC staff regarding current fire protection issues, the status of license renewal activities, proposed changes to the review process for subsequent Combined License applications and a position paper on incorporating international radiological protection recommendations into NRC regulations.

The ACRS advises the Commission, independently from the NRC staff, on safety issues related to the licensing and operation of nuclear power plants.

The meeting will be held in Room T-2B3 of the agency's Two White Flint North building, at 11545 Rockville Pike. Sessions on Thursday and Friday's will run from 8:30 a.m. to 7 p.m., and Saturday's session will run from 8:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. Portions of this meeting may be closed to protect proprietary information.
