NRC SCHEDULES PUBLIC MEETING TO DISCUSS SAFETY CULTURE AT NUCLEAR FUEL SERVICES

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff has scheduled a public meeting in Atlanta with officials of Nuclear Fuel Services on Wednesday, March 18 to discuss a plan to improve safety at the company's facility in Erwin, Tenn.

The meeting will begin at 1 p.m. (EST) at the NRC Region II office, located in the Sam Nunn Atlanta Federal Center, 61 Forsyth St., S.W., Suite 24T20. The meeting will be open to observation by the public, and NRC officials will be available at its conclusion to answer questions from interested observers.

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the status of the NFS Comprehensive Safety Culture Initiative. "Safety culture" refers to an organization's overall commitment to health and safety management. NFS agreed in 2007 to launch the program, designed to improve safety at the facility following a series of violations.
