## NRC RESCHEDULES MEETING TO DISCUSS SAFETY PERFORMANCE OF USEC'S PADUCAH GASEOUS DIFFUSION PLANT

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's public meeting in Paducah, Ky., to discuss its latest safety evaluation at United States Enrichment Corp.'s Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant, has been rescheduled for <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>May 24</u>. The meeting was originally scheduled for <u>May 10</u> but was postponed due to flooding in the area.

The meeting is scheduled to begin at 7 p.m. CST in the meeting room of the McCracken County Library, 555 Washington St., in Paducah. Members of the public can attend and observe the discussion, and will have an opportunity to ask questions or make comments to the NRC staff after the business portion of the meeting.

The NRC's evaluation of Paducah is called a Licensee Performance Review and covers the period of operation from Oct. 4, 2008 to Dec 31, 2010.

The NRC staff evaluated performance at the Paducah plant in five major areas: Safety Operations, Safeguards, Radiological Controls, Facility Support and Special Topics. NRC officials said the review determined that the Paducah plant continued to conduct its activities in a safe manner, and the agency found no areas needing improvement. NRC inspection of the facility will continue at its current level during the next 24-month review period.

However, the NRC issued three Confirmatory Orders during the assessment period, related in part to enhancements to the plant's safety conscious work environment. NRC officials said that, although the orders addressed issues that occurred before the assessment period, the agency will review the effectiveness of their implementation as a part of the core inspection program.
