OPENING REMARKS OF NRC CHAIRMAN GREGORY B. JACZKO AT TODAY'S BRIEFING TO THE COMMISSION FROM THE OFFICE OF HUMAN RESOURCES AND OFFICE OF SMALL BUSINESS AND CIVIL RIGHTS
