NRC TO DISCUSS 2010 PERFORMANCE ASSESSMENT FOR COLUMBIA GENERATING STATION

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff has scheduled an open house for June 21, in Richland, Wa., and will be available to discuss the agency's 2010 assessment of safety performance for the Columbia Generating Station. The plant, located near Richland, is operated by Energy Northwest.

The open house is informal and scheduled to begin at 6 p.m. at Energy Northwest's Business Services Center, 3000 George Washington Way, Richland.

There will be no formal presentation by NRC staff at the meeting. The NRC staff will be available to answer questions from the public on the safety performance of Columbia Generating Station, as well as the NRC's role in ensuring safe plant operation.

"The NRC continually reviews the performance of Columbia Generating Station and the nation's other commercial nuclear power facilities," NRC Region IV Administrator Elmo E. Collins said. "This meeting will provide an opportunity for a discussion of our annual assessment of safety performance with the company and with local officials and residents who live near the plant."

The NRC said the Columbia Generating Station operated safely during 2010 and will receive the detailed inspection regime during 2011 used by the NRC for plants that are operating safely. Inspections are performed by two NRC Resident Inspectors assigned to the plant and by inspection specialists from the Region IV Office in Arlington, Texas.

A letter sent from the NRC Region IV office to plant officials addresses the performance of the plant during 2010 and will serve as the basis for the meeting discussion. It is available on the NRC web site at:
