NRC ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON MEDICAL USES OF ISOTOPES TELECONFERENCE MEETING OCT. 18

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Medical Uses of Isotopes (ACMUI) will convene a teleconference meeting on Oct. 18 to discuss the ACMUI Permanent Implant Brachytherapy Subcommittee Report.

The ACMUI advises the NRC on policy and technical issues related to the regulation of medical uses of certain radioactive materials.
