THIS TABLE INCLUDES DEFENDANTS IN ALL FELONY AND CLASS A MISDEMEANOR CASES, BUT INCLUDES ONLY THOSE PETTY OFFENSE DEFENDANTS WHOSE CASES HAVE BEEN ASSIGNED TO DISTRICT JUDGES. BEGINNING IN 2005, DEFENDANTS CHARGED IN TWO OR MORE CASES THAT WERE TERMINATED DURING THE REPORTING PERIOD ARE COUNTED SEPARATELY FOR EACH CASE. PREVIOUSLY, SUCH DEFENDANTS WERE COUNTED ONLY ONCE. THEREFORE, DATA FOR 2005 AND THEREAFTER ARE NOT COMPARABLE TO DATA PUBLISHED IN PREVIOUS YEARS.
