On January 4, 2011, on behalf of Bloomberg, L.P. (“Bloomberg”), Matthew Berry, Janet Fitzpatrick Moran, and I had a telephone call with Joshua Cinelli, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Michael Copps. The purpose of the call was to discuss the merger and transfer of control of licenses of NBC Universal, Inc. (“NBC Universal”) to Comcast Corporation (“Comcast”). In particular, there was a discussion of issues previously identified by Bloomberg in written submissions in this docket. The discussion focused on conditions that would be necessary to mitigate the competitive harms identified by Bloomberg in the event the Commission approves the merger, including a channel placement or neighborhooding requirement.
