On January 11, 2011, Matt Polka and Ross Lieberman, American Cable Association, William P. Rogerson, Professor, Northwestern University, and the undersigned had a phone conversation with John Flynn, Senior Counsel to the Chairman for Transactions, in regard to the above-referenced docket. We discussed with Mr. Flynn how to amend the conditions proposed by the Chairman to ensure they mitigate harms to smaller multichannel video programming distributors (MVPDs) from the proposed combination of Comcast and NBC Universal.
