U.S. Cellular anticipates filing additional information responsive to these Requests when it can be collected and assembled. U.S. Cellular seeks "Highly Confidential" treatment for this submission, in accordance with the guidelines set forth in the first and second protective orders in this proceeding.¹

Attachments A and B are submitted in response to Request No. 7 and Attachment C hereto is submitted in response to Request No. 8. Attachment A hereto is a chart depicting U.S. Cellular's Service Order Code ("SOC") "reference tables." SOCs are used as a means to identify equipment, features and services on a customer's account record. Attachment B hereto is a diagram showing the interrelation of the various reference tables, which also provides descriptive information about the various SOCs and their features.

Attachment C contains information responsive to Attachment B (Bidding) associated with Request No. 8. It is a competitive bid pricing spreadsheet describing U.S. Cellular "bids" for corporate accounts in 2010 and 2011. Provision of this information in lieu of information in
