Dear Ms. Dortch:

On December 20, 2010, Richard Wiley, Wayne Johnsen, and the undersigned of Wiley Rein LLP, as counsel to JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A., Administrative Agent under the Tribune Company Credit Agreement dated May 17, 2007 (“JPMorgan”), met with the following individuals in the Media Bureau’s Video Division: Barbara Kreisman, Division Chief; Clay Pendarvis, Associate Division Chief; David Roberts, Attorney Advisor; and Adrienne Denysyk, Attorney Advisor.

The meeting participants discussed the equity and other rights and interests that JPMorgan potentially will hold in Tribune upon its emergence from bankruptcy. In addition, the parties discussed JPMorgan’s plan to create a subsidiary for the purpose of holding and managing JPMorgan’s interests in Reorganized Tribune. The parties also noted that it is anticipated that an amendment to the pending FCC applications in this proceeding will be filed with the Commission in the near future to reflect this change in the manner in which JPMorgan intends to hold its interests in Tribune post-emergence.
