

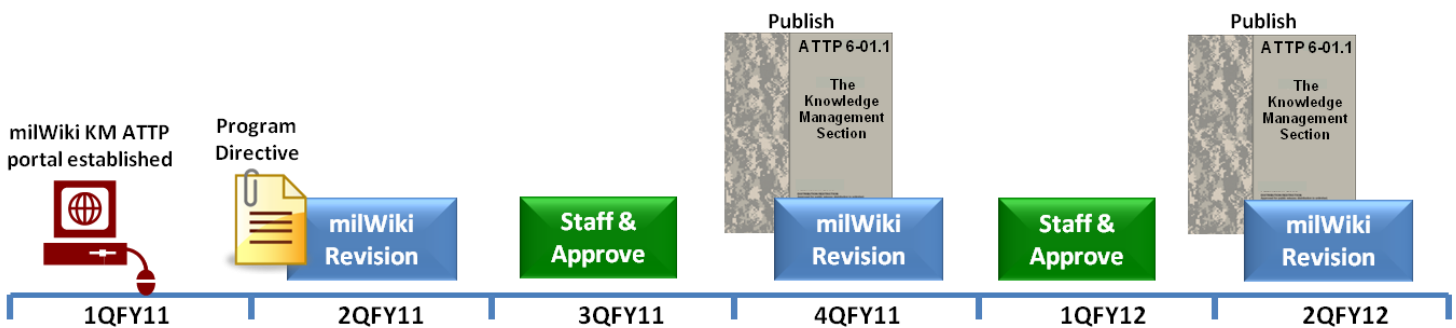
ARMY OPERATIONAL KNOWLEDGE MANAGEMENT

ATTP 6-01.1 REVISION



The Army Operational Knowledge Management (AOKM) Proponent Office is transforming FM 6-01.1, *Knowledge Management Section*, into an ATTP. The transformation leverages the power, flexibility and accessibility of milWiki to create a workspace that allows Knowledge Management practitioners from around the world to contribute the latest best practices and lessons learned into the manual on a consistent, recurring basis. The wiki process taps into the collective intelligence (KNOWLEDGE) of the entire KM Community of Practice as they read, add, and discuss new content. The new ATTP levels the playing field of doctrine creation, allowing multiple voices to be heard from a wide range of expertise.

The revision strategy is an incremental approach; KM professionals contribute their proposed modifications to the ATTP via milWiki, followed by quarterly formal staffing across the doctrine community. Several members of KMNet Professional Forum have already stepped forward to take on the challenge of revising the manual, bringing their experience in the field to bear with thoughtful contributions and excellent discussion.



The success of this effort hinges on additional quality input from the field across all segments of the KM Community, followed by a rapid review and publication process. The result will be a KM Section ATTP that is updated and published in six month intervals through a series of focused, quick-turn alterations. The desired endstate of this combination of informal and formal processes is a relevant, living, and operationally focused manual which truly prescribes the "how" of effectively integrating KM into full spectrum operations.
