V. Technical comments

As written, the legislation applies to a mixture of 3 separate products with Chapter 32 HTS subheadings cited for each. However, one HTS classification needs to be provided for the mixture as a whole. According to an e-mail from a National Import Specialist at U.S. Customs and Border Patrol (dated April 27, 2012), the mixture should be classified in HTS subheading 3204.12.50.

VI. Continuation

If enacted, the tariff relief provided for in this bill would be available to any entity that imports the product that is covered by the bill.
