### **V. Technical comments**

We suggest deleting the comma after "goggles" to be consistent with HTS usage, which omits the comma after the penultimate item in a series.

### **VI. Continuation**

The estimated customs revenue loss is based on a temporary reduction of the general rate of duty from 2.5 percent ad valorem to 1.0 percent, a reduction of 1.5 percentage points.

### A BILL

To reduce temporarily the rate of duty on parts of frames and mountings for spectacles, goggles, or the like.

3	SECTION 1. PARTS OF FRAMES AND MOUNTINGS FOR SPEC-					
4	TACLES, GOGGLES, OR THE LIKE.					
5	(a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of					
6	the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is					
7	amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following					
8	new heading:					
	" 9902.01.00 Parts of frames and mountings for spectacles, goggles, or the like (provided for in subheading 9003.90.00)					

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
- 3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day

4 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
