To extend the temporary suspension of duty on MCPB Acid and MCPB Sodium Salt.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. MCPB ACID AND MCPB SODIUM SALT.
- 4 (a) In General.—Heading 9902.22.94 of the Har-
- 5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 6 MCPB Acid and MCPB Sodium Salt) is amended by
- 7 striking the date in the effective period column and insert-
- 8 ing "12/31/2015".
- 9 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 10 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or

- 1 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 2 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
