The mixture consisting of isoxaflutole and cyprosulfamide provides broad-spectrum weed control both on contact and then reactivating to kill late-emerging weeds. Isoxaflutole and cyprosulfamide are sourced from Finland and Germany, respectively. The interested entity stated it converts the majority of the foreign-sourced product(s) to the formulated product addressed in this legislation in a U.S. Foreign Trade Zone.

7 mixtures containing Isoxaflutole and Cyprosulfamide) is
8 amended—

9 (1) by striking "3.5%" and inserting "2.7%";

(2) by striking the date in the effective period
 column and inserting "12/31/2015".

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
4 subsection (a) apply with respect to goods entered, or
5 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
6 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.

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
