A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on used camshafts and crankshafts for diesel engines.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	$tives\ of\ the\ United\ States\ of\ America\ in\ Congress\ assembled,$
3	SECTION 1. USED CAMSHAFTS AND CRANKSHAFTS FOR
4	DIESEL ENGINES.
5	(a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6	the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7	amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8	new heading:
	" 9902.01.00 Used camshafts and crankshafts for diesel engines (provided for in subheading 8483.10.30) Free No change No change On or before 12/31/2015 ".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after

4 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
