A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain women's footwear not covering the ankle.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. CERTAIN WOMEN'S FOOTWEAR NOT COVERING
4	THE ANKLE.
5	(a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6	the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7	amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8	new heading:
	" 9902.01.00 Women's footwear with uppers of furskin, valued over \$30/pair, not covering the ankle (provided for in subheading 6405.90.90) Free No change No change On or before 12/31/2015 ".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after

4 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
