II. Suggested article description(s) for enactment (including appropriate HTS subheading(s)):

Acrylic fiber tow containing 98 percent or more by weight of acrylonitrile units, 2 percent or more but not more than 4 percent of water, and not more than 30 ppm of sodium, the foregoing consisting of up to 3 sub-bundles each containing 50,000 filaments (plus or minus 10 percent) and with average filament measuring 1.2 decitex (plus or minus 0.1 decitex) (provided for in subheading 5501.30.00)

(If enacted, the tariff relief provided for in this bill would be available to any entity that imports the product that is covered by the bill.)
