To extend the temporary reduction of duty on liquid-filled glass bulbs designed for sprinkler systems and other release devices.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. LIQUID-FILLED GLASS BULBS DESIGNED FOR
- 4 SPRINKLER SYSTEMS AND OTHER RELEASE
- 5 **DEVICES.**
- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.24.26 of the Har-
- 7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 8 certain liquid-filled glass bulbs) is amended by striking the
- 9 date in the effective period column and inserting "12/31/
- 10 2015".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after

4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
