Description:

The team will design and build a demonstration cellulosic ethanol plant in Boardman, Oregon, expanding the production of ethanol beyond the Midwest U.S.

Participants: BioGasol, LLC; and U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE) Joint Bioenergy Institute (DOE's Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory and Sandia National Laboratories)

Production:

- Capacity of 2.7 million gallons per year.

Technology & Feedstocks:

- BioGasol proprietary conversion process.
- Wheat straw, corn stover and poplar residuals, all derived from within a 50-mile radius of the plant.

State of Readiness:

- Co-located at Pacific Ethanol's existing ethanol plant in Boardman, Oregon.
- Estimated to be operational in 2009, with expansion to commercial scale by 2012.
