The Science, Technology & Business Division provides reference and bibliographic services and develops the general LC collections in the areas of science, technology, business and economics (with the exception of clinical medicine and technical agriculture, which are the subject specialties of the National Library of Medicine and the National Agricultural Library respectively.) This collection comprises roughly 40 percent of the Library's total book and journal collection.

The session will offer attendees a choice of one of two tours -- a business tour and a science tour. The tours will provide an overview of the respective research facilities, services, print and digital collections and databases available to federal librarians.
