FEDLINK is establishing contracts to replace the current FEDLINK serials contracts which expire at the end of the 2010 federal fiscal year. If you currently use or would like to start using the FEDLINK serials contract and the total dollar value of your list is over \$3,000, your serials list will need to be competed against the new contracts. The new contract period begins in Fiscal Year 2011 on October 1, 2010.
