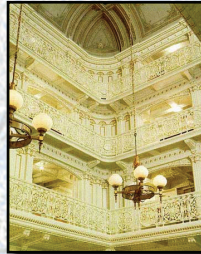

The Executive Office of the President (EOP) Library supports the information needs of the President, his White House advisers, and EOP organizations such as the Office of Management and Budget and the National Security Council. The library originated with the Bureau of the Budget Library in the 1930s. Service is currently provided via the Virtual Library on the EOP intranet and by librarians who conduct general and legal research on behalf of EOP clients.

The program will include a welcome and overview of services and collections, demonstration of the Virtual Library and tours of the two libraries, located in the New Executive Office Building and the Eisenhower Executive Office Building.

To enter the building, you will need a picture identification (preferably a driver's license). A librarian will be standing by to escort guests. Immediately following the New Executive Office Building visit, the guests will be escorted to the Eisenhower Executive Office Building for the second orientation and tour.
