**UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO MOVE TO QUASH  
SUBPOENA**

Samsung Semiconductor Inc. ("Samsung"), a non-party to the above-captioned case, through undersigned counsel, files this motion for a brief extension of time for Samsung to file a motion to quash The Federal Trade Commission's Subpoena Duces Tecum, dated October 11, 2002 (the "Subpoena").

The Federal Trade Commission ("FTC") served Samsung with the Subpoena on October 14, 2002. However, October 14, 2002 was a federal holiday; thus, under the applicable procedures, the time to file a motion to quash the Subpoena would be October 25, 2002.

Counsel are negotiating an agreement to resolve Samsung's complaints about the scope and burden of the Subpoena and other issues regarding the Subpoena. However, due to the complexity of the issues and the scope of the Subpoena, as well as the need to communicate across time zones with as much as fourteen-hour differences, this negotiation is not complete.


Samsung and the FTC have agreed to an extension of time to file a motion to quash the Subpoena to at least October 31, 2002. The extension is not sought for delay, but only to allow for the resolution of this discovery dispute without litigation (if possible).

Counsel for the Federal Trade Commission do not oppose this extension.

Accordingly, Samsung requests that this motion be granted and that it be given until October 31, 2002 to file a motion to quash the Subpoena, without prejudice to seek a further extension of this deadline.


