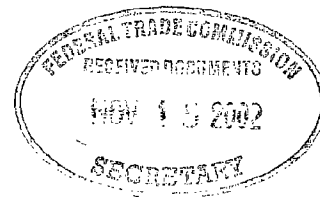

**FOURTH UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO MOVE TO QUASH SUBPOENA**

Samsung Semiconductor Inc. ("Samsung"), a non-party to the above-captioned case, through undersigned counsel, files this fourth motion for a brief extension of time for Samsung to file a motion to quash Rambus' Subpoena Duces Tecum ("Subpoena").

Rambus served Samsung with the Subpoena on October 1, 2002. Under the applicable procedures, Samsung has moved for and received extensions of time to file a motion to quash the Subpoena. Samsung's most recent motion for extension of time was filed on October 31, 2002 wherein Samsung sought an extension of time to further negotiate with opposing counsel concerning the scope of the Subpoena. The present deadline for Samsung to file a motion to quash the Subpoena is November 15, 2002.

Counsel for Samsung and Rambus have telephonically conferred in an attempt to resolve complaints about the scope and burden of the Subpoena and other issues regarding the Subpoena. To date, Samsung has produced approximately 55,000 pages of documents to the parties in response to their subpoenas. In addition, Samsung has prepared and produced summary charts presenting requested information. Samsung

anticipates that the production of additional documents and information will be completed shortly.


Samsung and Rambus have agreed to further extend the time for Samsung to respond to or file a motion to quash the Subpoena to at least, and including, December 6, 2002. The extension is not sought for delay, but only to allow for the resolution of this discovery dispute without litigation (if possible).

Counsel for the Federal Trade Commission do not oppose this extension.

Accordingly, Samsung requests that this motion be granted and that it be given until December 6, 2002 to respond or file a motion to quash, without prejudice to seeking a further extension of this deadline.


