**UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO MOVE TO LIMIT SUBPOENA**

Non-parties Gordon Kelley, Mark Kellogg, Howard Kalter, Kenneth Grillo and Jim Rogers ("IBM Current and Former Employees") file this motion for a brief extension of time for them to file a motion to limit Rambus Incorporated's ("Rambus") Subpoenas Duces Tecum and Subpoenas Ad Testificandum which were issued October 28, 2002.

Rambus served the Current and Former Employees with the subpoenas on November 14, 2002. Under the applicable procedures, the time to file a motion to limit the Subpoenas is November 25, 2002.

On November 15th counsel for IBM Current and Former Employees and for Rambus conferred in the attempt to resolve IBM's concerns about the scope and other issues relating to the Subpoena. One issue that remains outstanding is the result of negotiations between the FTC and Rambus relating to the use of depositions taken in prior civil proceedings in this proceeding. Counsel are still in the process of negotiating in an attempt to resolve IBM's concerns regarding the scope and burden of the Subpoenas. However, due in large part to no

resolution between the FTC and Rambus on the use of prior depositions in the current proceeding, IBM and Rambus have not completed their negotiations.

IBM and Rambus have agreed to an extension of time to file a motion to limit the Subpoenas to November 27, 2002. The extension is not sought for delay, but only to allow for the possible resolution of certain issues relating to the Current and Former IBM Employee's obligations under the Subpoenas.


Counsel for Rambus does not oppose this extension.
