Non-Party SimSci-Esscor (“SimSci”) files this motion to extend the time permitted for SimSci to move to quash or limit Aspen Technology, Inc.’s, (“Aspen”) Subpoena Duces Tecum which was issued on October 23, 2003.

Aspen served SimSci with the October 23, 2003 Subpoena on January 14, 2004. Under the applicable procedures of the Federal Trade Commission Rules of Practice, the time to file a motion to quash or limit the Subpoena would be January 26, 2004.


Counsel are still in the process of negotiating in an attempt to resolve SimSci’s concerns regarding the scope and burden of the Subpoena. Given the scope of Aspen’s document request, and the complexity of the underlying issues, more time will be required for SimSci and Aspen to complete their negotiations.

Counsel for Aspen have agreed to an extension of time for SimSci to file a motion to quash or limit the Subpoena to February 4, 2004.

Accordingly, SimSci respectfully requests that this motion be granted and that it be given until February 4, 2004 to file a motion to quash or limit the Subpoena Duces Tecum issued on October 23, 2003.


