In connection with the damage suit filed against law enforcement agencies in the Charlotte, N. C., area by the Afro-American Unity Organization, which group was desiring affiliation with the BPP, this matter has been followed periodically with the USA.

On 8/21/70 [redacted] USA's Office, Charlotte, made available to SA [redacted] a copy of the order of dismissal of proceedings as they pertain to 17 of the 18 plaintiffs, noting the suit is still in effect as to MICHAEL GRANT LANEY.

On 8/21/70 AUSA DAVID SENTELLE, WDNC, Charlotte, advised motions for dismissal of the proceedings as filed by the attorneys representing the Federal defendants, which include SA L. DEAN PAARMANN of the FBI, have not been acted upon by Judge MC MILLAN.

Charlotte will follow and report pertinent developments.

Based on the above, the group's major income appears to be sales of newspapers from which they would receive \$875 per week or approximately \$3,500 per month. It is noted that in referenced communication, mention was made of the fact that DOUGLAS PAUL MIRANDA had traveled from Winston-Salem, N. C., to New Haven, Conn., and information has now been received from San Francisco sources that \$200 was sent from national headquarters to MIRANDA on the instructions of DAVID HILLIARD during June which would have covered his travels.

B. Foreign Sources

None reported.

C. Expenses

One half of the group's newspaper income or \$1,750 would be required by national headquarters. However, observation indicates the group would have the previous week's newspapers on hand at the time their next shipment arrives which would indicate they are not selling all of their newspapers.

Their rent of \$17.50 per week continues along with their electric bill of approximately \$15 per month.

In connection with shipments of newspapers, it is noted that on 7/9/70 freight insurance and other charges were \$130.42; 7/23/70 \$157.79; and 7/30/70 \$161.60.

Based on this, it would indicate that each Thursday their shipment of newspapers arrives with approximate cost of \$150. With there being five Thursdays in July, 1970, it would indicate that they paid \$750 in expenses to Piedmont Airlines.

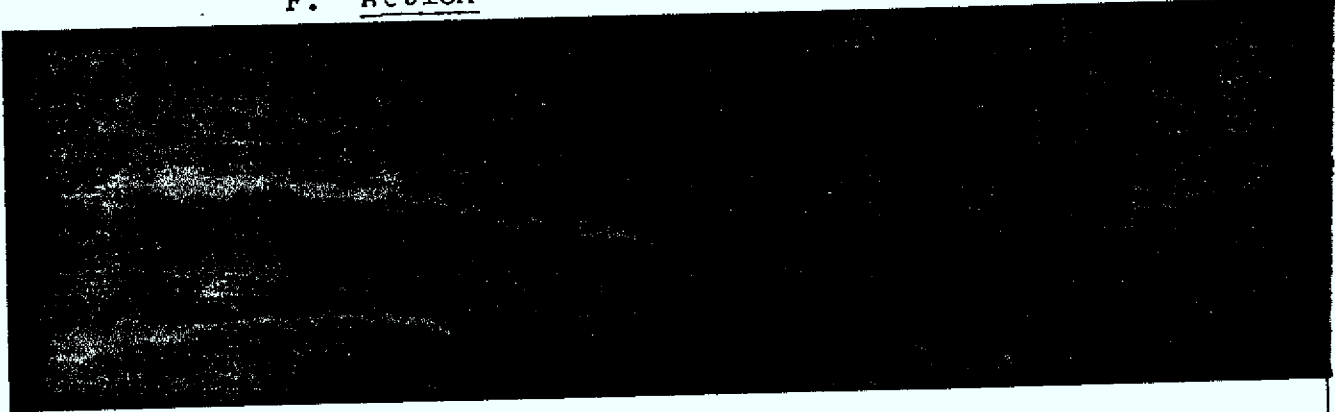

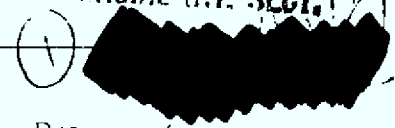

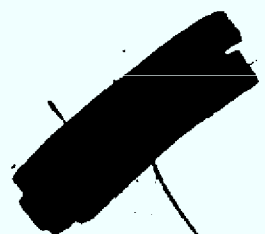

Winston-Salem National Committee to Combat Fascism (NCCF) continues to operate as a BPP recognized organization with headquarters at 1602 E. 14th St., Winston-Salem. Weapons are reportedly maintained at this address and they regularly receive and sell the BPP newspaper. They hold political education classes and "liberation schools" where BPP matters are discussed, calling for abstinence from alcohol and drugs as this would affect the members' effectiveness in the coming revolution. National leaders visited Winston-Salem during 7/70. Sources report the group calls for arming against the "pigs." Articles from the BPP newspaper referring to Winston-Salem, N. C., set forth. [REDACTED] showing contacts with other recognized groups set forth.

For some time now (since Sept of '69 to be exact) the committee has been reminding the businesses within the Black community of their responsibility to the people of this community. The committee asked all businesses to donate food or money to buy food, weekly to the Free Lunch and Breakfast Program held everyday Monday thru Friday to feed hungry children.

Here almost a year later we find that you have not made your position clear, as to whether you can relate to feeding hungry children or not. The same children who parents patronize your businesses with the small income that they do have; the same parents who so often make the difference as to whether your business will make a profit or a loss.

At this time, because the number of children in the people's program increase daily, we find it necessary to make our position clear. Since we can not turn hungry children away, if the businesses refuse to put back some of the tremendous amount of money they take out of the community by donating to the Free Lunch and Breakfast Program, we will have to take this to a higher level. We will take it to the people. The same people who make the difference between a loss or a profit to your business.

.III. TEACHING OF THE REVOLUTIONARY
PROGRAM

[REDACTED] LARRY LITTLE conducted an indoctrination talk at the BPP Headquarters wherein he said there would be a revolution in the near future and told those present to get a gun, preferably a big gun, saying that a .44 magnum might be his choice. LITTLE was very derogatory regarding President NIXON's policies, ranging from the Vietnam War to welfare, claiming that NIXON takes people's money and gives only a little back to a few. He commented about the police department using war type tactics against the Black Panthers and during his discussion it was apparent he had a strong grudge against Chief of Police JUSTICE TUCKER. There was considerable discussion about writing an article concerning the fact that even after BOBBY RAY STOVER received his undesirable discharge from the military, he was still harassed by the Winston-Salem Police Department as a deserter. U

[REDACTED] a political education class continues each morning from 8:00 until 11:30 a.m. for small children between the ages of approximately four and ten. The attendance is usually in the range of twenty. U

On July 7, 1970, SF T-16 reported that information concerning the curriculum for the Liberation Schools was furnished to Winston-Salem, North Carolina, where it was reported that there were twenty people at the Liberation School. According to SF T-16, JOAN KELLY is Director of the Liberation School for BPP Headquarters. U

On July 21, 1970, SF T-16 reported that JOAN KELLY had in the recent past traveled in the Eastern part of the United States, including Winston-Salem, North Carolina, and the purpose of these travels was to contact individuals concerning BPP programs, including the Breakfast Program. U

On July 13, 1970, NY T-66 reported that members of the NCCF, Winston-Salem, North Carolina, in their daily report, set forth that they had had physical training, political education and drill. U

[REDACTED] LARRY LITTLE, the "Red Book"

by MAO TSE-TUNG and a book called "Match for 100" by KIM L. SUNG from North Korea. [REDACTED] Also, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] letters from BOBBY SEALE who is currently in prison. On these occasions LITTLE is critical of local government and the white man who is allegedly benefiting from the poverty and degradation of the Negro race. LITTLE states that the Mayor of Winston-Salem is a racist pig and should be dead, but he never recommends that anyone shoot anyone else outright. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] he has been saying that HEWEY P. NEWTON has advised that one should be very careful not to get the revolutions mixed up as the revolution in Africa is not the same as the revolution in America, as things are different here. LITTLE calls the liaison officials with the police department "Nigger boot lickers" and says they will be dealt with in a revolutionary manner when the revolution starts. This apparently means that they will be shot. Another favorite topic is that they should take control of all black grocers to meet the needs of the people. Recently LITTLE has been talking about the Constitution of the United States, saying that the Constitution was signed by people who had slaves and it is apparent that the Constitution was not written for Negro people. He calls President NIXON "Tricky Dicky" and says he wants to spread United States imperialism by barbaric action throughout the world. LITTLE states black people should not fight the war in Vietnam but should group together to kill the avaricious beast, meaning the white power structure. (

MEMBER OF [REDACTED] ORGANIZATION

[REDACTED] conducted by NELSON MALLOY. [REDACTED] an article in the BPP paper concerning shooting of police officers was discussed. MALLOY said that the panthers should do this in defense of their lives, homes and rights as the police department abuses all of these and the panthers. MALLOY referred to the police department as "armies occupying Babylon" and their search and arrest warrants mean nothing as they are not legal in relation to the people. (

The following is the article "Organizing Self-Defense Groups," parts 1 - 8:

PART # 1

In organizing self-defense groups at this stage of the struggle the most important consideration is whether or not the person to be incorporated into the group understands fully that what he or she is doing is the right thing to do. At this stage of the struggle if any members of a self-defense group are weak minded or do not understand that the only way to put an end to brutality is to bring by this racist power structure is to organize self-defense groups to counter-attack, practiced as shown that if this weak minded person is ever captured he or she will certainly not be able to withstand the methods of persuasion used by the fascist pigs and they will talk, give up information, so the first priority for any self-defense group is to organize ideologically.

Because of the consequences if anything goes wrong during an operation, members within the group must maintain a face to face relationship, get to know each others strengths and weaknesses thoroughly, and participate fully in the planning of operations. Liberalism at this level can cost the lives of comrades and/or jeopardize the success of an operation.

At this time self-defense groups should have no more than four to six members. The struggle at this time requires an operation that can't be handled by four to six people. Also security is sacrificed the larger the group. At this time self-defense groups should be formed all across Babylon, North, South, East and West. However, at this time groups must work autonomously. Under no circumstances should any group seek out and try to make contact with another group. Due to the fact that this level of struggle is in its embryonic stages and fools, agents and provocateurs are scattered all across Babylon if autonomy is maintained when a member of a group is captured he or she will only be able to give us information on the group, their own.

Know the enemy. At this time the pigs have three things going for them:

1. Communication
2. Mobility
3. Information C.M.I.

When planning any operation the pigs' C.M.I. must be taken into account when planning tactics.

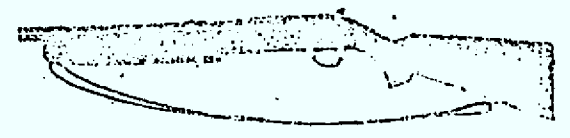
revolver, in reality this is very practical and shouldn't be attempted unless you are expert's expert. From what I know Wyatt Earp and Al had too many people think that if you have a hand gun either pistol or revolver that they are good anything. All that is necessary give you a different perspective to examine the armament of pigs that occupy our Black communities anywhere in the world. When you do that you will cover that most jdg cars have at least one .12 gauge pump or automatic shotgun, one or two automatic or automatic rifles, one or two bat-action with a scope mounted for sniping purposes, and, of course, they have strapped on at least one gun either an automatic pistol or a revolver. In San Francisco S.F. Tactical Squad men carry two handguns, their standard service revolver; second handgun which is their personal preference, in many cases an automatic pistol. So at this let's examine these three of weapons-the shotgun, the revolver, and the handgun.

.12 GAUGE SHOTGUN- In use the shotgun, either pump or semi-automatic, loaded with buckshot generally in situations such as rebellion standard load is also 190 buckshot per shell. However, the magnum load of 12 pellets shell. These magnum loads be used only in magnum size. If you use magnum loads in regular shotgun, you might as well tell it.

Due to the brainwashing done by TV, movies, comics etc., there are a lot of incorrect ideas about firearms that must be cleared up. The first thing to understand is, there is no one piece (gun) that covers any and all situations. Although they show pigs on TV and in the movies killing people a block away with a snout-nose .38

proper sight alignment. Sight alignment is lining up your front sight with your rear sight correctly. Your front sight lined up with your rear sight and both lined up on the target is called the "sight picture". The correct sight picture basically is having the front not too high or too low, not to the right or to the left, but is with the target resting on top of the front sight. The sight picture will not always appear perfect, but if the correct sight picture is understood practice will bring improvement.

The next thing to get down with is trigger squeeze. That's right you squeeze the trigger, you don't pull it or jerk it, contrary to what ever you saw on T.V., trigger squeeze is a process of putting slow steady pressure on the trigger until a shot goes off. If you try to anticipate the shot, you will jerk and mess up your aim.

One other thing to watch for is movement of your piece which comes from breathing, which also messes up your aim. One method of breath control is to take a deep breath, let out half of it, hold the rest of it then begin your trigger squeeze.

It would be ideal if you could incorporate into your group a veteran of the pigs' military service. Veterans are of great value and assistance in helping with the above training also when you are ready to begin practice with live ammunition. When practicing with live ammo make sure your location is where you won't be hassled by pigs. Actual combat conditions can be deadly as a training ground. When practicing with live ammo, remember it is valuable. Don't just start popping caps for the heck of it; the whole purpose is to prepare yourself to be "a Match for One Hundred" which will only come about as a result of correct practice.

One thing to guard against is flinching. Flinching is caused by being intimidated by the sound and kick of your weapon. With proper trigger squeeze and breath control, you won't have any problems with flinching. If you have problems keeping all your shots in a fairly small group or if you have a problem just getting your shots on the target anywhere you are probably flinching. Have someone watch you as you fire and they will be able to tell you whether or not you are flinching.

One more thing in the training of members of a self defense group is to know how to handle the various types of handguns. The various types of handguns are...

I will be happy to provide you that we must build a new power structure to replace the old one. What I mean is the image of that you see the communist pig in the society is in the service of the racist capitalist system. They control the educational institutions, the news media and the means of production to turn out all the educational material. We sometimes are trapped by the rhetoric (words) of the slavemaster. In our 400 year struggle for survival it has been the guns and force manifested in the racist pig cops that occupy our communities that directly oppress, repress, brutalize and murder us. So for us to talk about survival we must talk about self-defense against this brutality and murder that is defined by the racist power structure as justifiable homicide. So when a self-defense group moves against this oppressive system, by executing a pig by any means, shooting, stabbing, bombing, etc., in defense against the 400 years of racist brutality and murder this can only be defined correctly as self-defense. The slavemaster, however, through his lackeys and lackeys calls it "terrorism", the work of crazed men, criminals, insane killers etc. We must define our struggle not the pigs. Carlos Marichella, an urban guerrilla in Brazil who was assassinated Nov. 4th 1969 just one month before Fred Hampton and Mark Clark, says, "the accusation of assault or terrorism no longer has the pejorative (negative) meaning it used to have. It has acquired new clothing, a new coloration. It does not factionalize, it does not discredit, on the contrary it represents a focal point of attraction."

"Today to be an assassin or terrorist is a quality that nobles any honorable man because it is an act worthy of a revolutionary engaged in armed struggle against the shameful military dictatorship and its monstrosities.

So with that, I say this, all self-defense groups must strike

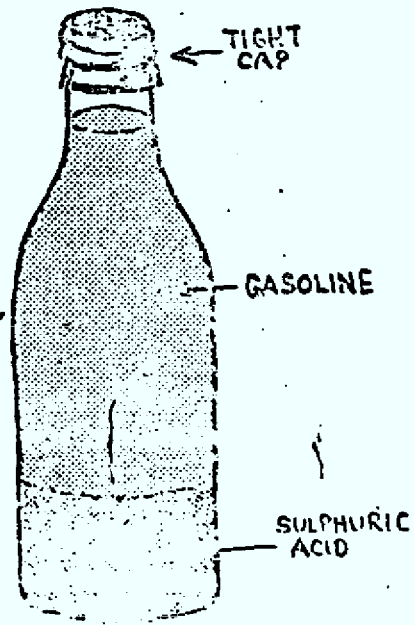
Below are some recipes that might help some of you get started.

SELF IGNITING MOLOTOV COCKTAIL
CAUTION: POTASSIUM CHLORATE IS VERY VOLATILE. IT CAN IGNITE ALMOST SPONTANEOUSLY IN THIS MIXTURE. IT

CAN BE IGNITED OR DETONATED BY A SINGLE SPARK EXCESSIVE HEAT OR BY THE FRICTION OF SKIN. THE INGREDIENTS TOGETHER SO USE PLASTIC OR WOOD UTENSILS FOR MIXING. DO NOT USE METAL. USE EXTREME CAUTION.

Mix 3 parts of potassium chlorate with 2 parts of sulfur. Add water to make a slurry. Take a large sock, soak in mixture then dry. Keep dry away from heat.

Away from the area or after have thoroughly cleaned the where you handled the above mixture take a fifth wine bottle fill 1/5 to 1/4 full of sulphuric acid. Fill the rest of the with gasoline. Pour the mixture in could bubble and heat up. the bottle tightly. Make sure doesn't leak you should test first with water. To cap the bottle is preferable to use a stop with a rubber blunger because it eats plastic and metal. Don't let the bottle hold it upright. We ready to use, put the bottle in the sock soaked in the calor sugar mix and knot the sock at top. Throw at target. When it hits and the glass breaks it will explode as the sulphuric acid contacts the potassium chlorate and sugar mixture on the sock. The potassium chlorate and sugar there is a explosion that gives off a lot of heat. The more potassium chlorate the more explosive, the more sulphuric acid the more heat. For maximum effect, mix the mixture with water even if the mixture is too dry is wet. However, it is not volatile when dry.



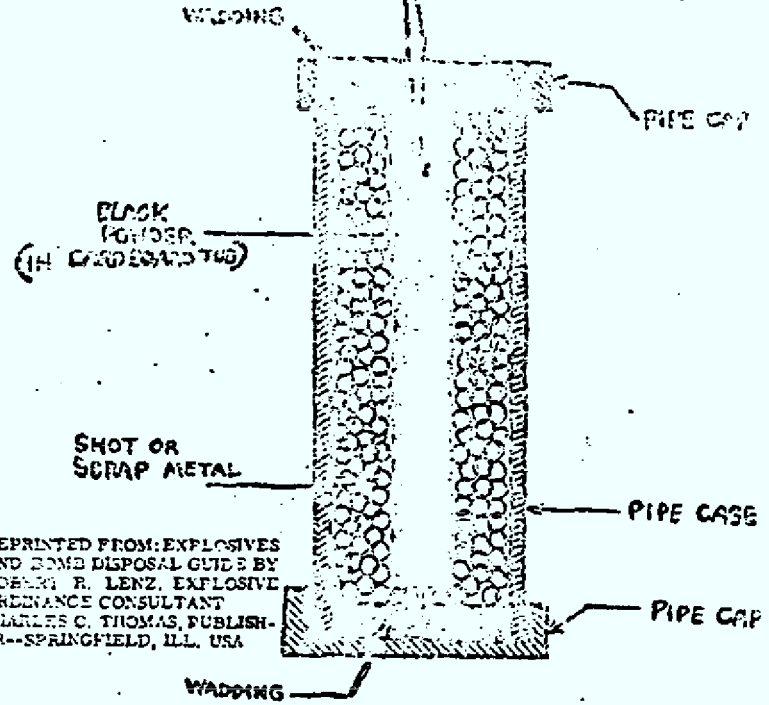
DO NOT SHAKE

PEOPLE'S HAND GRENADE

Take a (well) pipe about 2 1/2 in diameter and 12" long with caps to screw on at ends. Screw on bottom cap then put wadding in the bottom. (Wadding can consist of cardboard, paper, or toilet tissue) for tighter packing and prevent leaking out. Put in about one inch of shot or scrap metal, then put tube with BLACK POWDER packed in it and put fuse into pipe taped at ends, then pour shot or scrap metal between tube and pipe wall (as shown in drawing) leave about one inch space at top of pipe for top wadding (don't put wadding tightly around fuse) Put top pipe cap on and tighten. Then bend to side of pipe and tape to keep it from being pulled out.

This handgrenade should be tested by using a small amount of ingredients, then taken out away from people so the person using it could test his work before moving on his or her objective. will normally move outward in all directions or could have some directional pattern, depending upon the placement of the container.

Part 5 HOW TO COMBAT C.M.I.

The principal of Juche (Self-Reliance) clarified by Eldridge Cleaver, the Minister of Information of the Black Panther Party, is "Use what you got to get what you need." To answer the question of how do you combat the pigs' C.M.I. (communication, mobility and information), we must first determine what we have going for ourselves. Checking out the prac-

tice of self-defense groups, we see that we have the power to determine what is to happen, when it is to happen and how it is supposed to go down. What, When and How (W.W.H.) - the element of surprise. The pigs have C.M.I. and self-defense groups have W.W.H.

To consider a self-defense operation successful is not to just plan and execute but to plan, execute AND escape. There have been too many instances where members of self-defense groups have planned and executed righteous blows against this racist system only to be captured, wounded or killed. These are the consequences for revolutionary activity, however we must keep casualties within an acceptable minimum. The

slogan must be Maximum Damage to the Enemy, Minimum Damage to Us. Practice has shown that when planning W.W.H. if it is done with knowledge and understanding of C.M.I. casualties will be kept within an acceptable minimum. Too often, much attention is given to a plan up to the point of execution without giving the same attention to evasion and escape, that phase of the operation that determines success. This is a subjective approach, a onesided approach. W.W.H. is only one side of the coin, C.M.I. is the other side. Because self-defense groups use W.W.H., the pigs' C.M.I. does not go into operation until a self-defense group commits itself by actually executing some type of self-defense activity.

All of us should be aware once C.M.I. is activated pigs showing on the set from 30 sec to 1 minute maximum in a major city in Babylon, there the success or failure of a self-defense operation is dependent on the attention given to C.M.I. and the planning of evasion and escape. As I see it, learning to deal the pigs' C.M.I. is the number military problem facing revolutionary forces in Babylon. It is time for all who have got things to teach, by example, to forward. And remember, to honorably, one does not need company.



Part 6 ON REVOLVERS

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:

1. Check to see if gun is loaded. You do this on a revolver by swinging out the cylinder. Pull back on the cylinder latch and gently push out on the cylinder.
2. Keep your finger off the trigger unless practicing trigger squeeze or firing.
3. Point your gun away from where someone may be shot. Point in the direction you are firing, but never over your point, make sure no one is in the way and can be shot.

KINDS OF REVOLVERS:

- .38 Snubnose - This gun has only a 2" barrel and shoots 38's. It is very easy to conceal.
- .38 Special - Has a 4" barrel and shoots 38's.
- .357 Magnum - This is the type of handgun the pig carries. The ammo for this is .357 magnum. Most piercing bullets will pierce an engine block. This is the best type of revolver to have.
- .41 and .44 Magnums - Have more knock down power than a .357 Magnum. But they carry four or five shots. They will go through a car door and .443 ammunition is very hard to get.

der latch with right hand. (#3) Push out cylinder with the fingers of left hand. Now that you have swung out the cylinder and the bullets are visible you gently push down on the extractor and let bullets drop out into your right hand.

LOADING:

To load, simply follow the same steps in unloading the cylinder. Then drop bullets into the chambers of your cylinder. Gently push cylinder closed, and you are ready to fire. DO NOT SLAM CYLINDER CLOSED, this causes extra wear on your gun.

COCKING A REVOLVER:

Put the tip of your thumb on the hammer, push your thumb up and to the right, and the hammer will cock. This is called single action firing.

locks back. You gun is ready to fire, do not put your finger in the trigger until you are ready to fire! After cocking hammer place your thumb directly on the frame beside the hammer, resting the tip of your thumb on the cylinder latch.

Your forefinger should be placed on the other side of the straight out just above the trigger guard until ready to fire. At the time you cock the hammer, after firing, this is called single action firing.

UNCOCKING A REVOLVER (LOADED)

With gun already cocked, place your thumb on the hammer, push down with the gun thumb, and the hammer will uncock. This is called double action firing. The hammer will fall and the gun will fire.

STEPS IN FIRING A REVOLVER:

The following steps must be observed in accurate shooting. If you don't pay attention to all four steps you will end up shooting just anywhere. Before you can learn to just draw and shoot you must observe these steps with your gun unloaded, until you can get them down pat, you will be able to see if you are following them correctly by the way you shoot.



DYNAMIC (DEFENSE)

POSITIONS IN FIRING:

There are two positions in firing (shown below). Each one is used for a different battle condition. The prone position is for when you are being shot at and you

1. Sight Alignment is aligning your rear sight and front sight together.
2. Sight Picture is placing the sights on your target with your sights already aligned.
3. Breath Control consists of taking a breath, letting a little out, holding there until you have completed your trigger squeeze and the shot has been fired.
4. Trigger squeeze is very important in accurate shooting. When shooting single action apply slow steady pressure on the trigger. The shot should not be anticipated, it should not be a surprise to you.

REVOLVER TERMS

SINGLE ACTION: cocking the hammer each time before firing. Cock the hammer and then pull the trigger.

DOUBLE ACTION: just pulling the trigger each time, not cocking the hammer first. Try not to jerk or snap the trigger. The action is fast but smooth.

POINTING: the process of firing quickly without using sight alignment. You simply crank and point the barrel at your target and fire.

RAPID FIRING: drawing, pointing, and shooting double-action. When you practice rapid firing, shoot off two shots in succession as quickly as possible.

CLEANING YOUR REVOLVER:

For all of the revolvers listed at the beginning of the article you can use a .38 caliber cleaning kit. You will need a cleaning rod, bore brush tip, .38 caliber cleaning patches, cleaning solvent, and gun oil. For patches you can use material like flannel, and some types of cotton, any material that does not pavel or is very liny, cut into circles about 2" in diameter. All of this cleaning material can be purchased in any gun store.

Your revolver should be cleaned twice a week, and every time after firing. Keep it free of dirt and dampness to avoid rusting. If you do not clean your gun immediately after firing it can cause corrosion of the barrel and eat away at it causing your shooting to become inaccurate because of holes that can develop from the powder eating away at the metal or rust from a lack of cleaning and dampness.

1. After firing your barrel and chambers in the cylinder have to be scrubbed with your bore brush and solvent every time. Attach brush to rod, dip brush in solvent, and use a brisk movement in and out of barrel and chambers in cylinder, cleaning out all of the particles out by holding barrel up to light to see if it shines inside, and you will be able to see any particles still holding on.

7. Put more cleaning solvent on it and wipe off your tractor and all other metal parts (outside of cylinder, and the side of the gun. Cock the hammer and wipe it off thoroughly. a couple of drops of oil down the hammer).

4. After cleaning the barrel of cylinder, take a patch with a little solvent on it and wipe off your tractor and all other metal parts (outside of cylinder, and the side of the gun. Cock the hammer and wipe it off thoroughly. a couple of drops of oil down the hammer).

5. Take a patch and with a couple of drops of oil on it rub your revolver, (all metal parts). There should be no visible finger prints on your revolver. Excessive streaks on the surface. Your gun should not have any surface, just apply enough oil for protection against rust.

6. Sometimes for extra hard get areas you will have to use a toothbrush dipped into oil solvent and brush briskly the hard to get areas. Sometimes your brush will not remove all the rust. In that case use fine steel wool and solvent, rubbing lightly to remove rust.

***For normal cleaning just use a patch through the barrel of cylinder and wipe off the solvent with a few drops of oil on it.

The first weapon that we will deal with is the AR-15/16, which is the latest development combat weaponry. This rifle is used by the fascist pig army Viet Nam. It was a replacement for the M-16. The M-16 is a 5.56 mm, magazine fed, gas-operated, air-cooled, shoulder weapon. Changing the position of a select lever, the rifle can be made to shoot fully automatic. The rifle also has a flash suppressor mounted on the muzzle. The barrel is surrounded by a heat shield material.

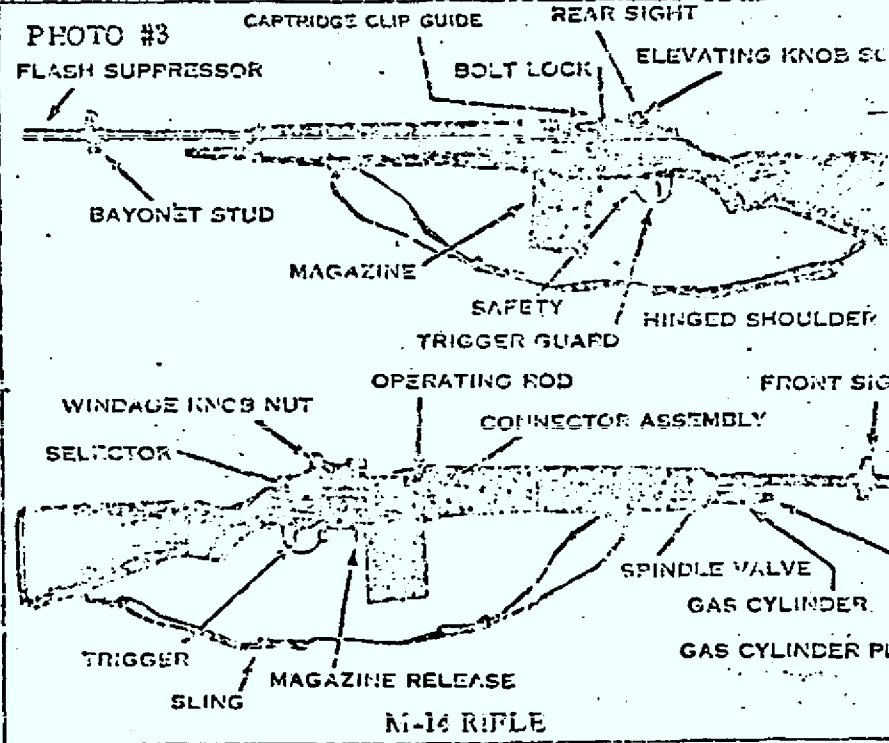
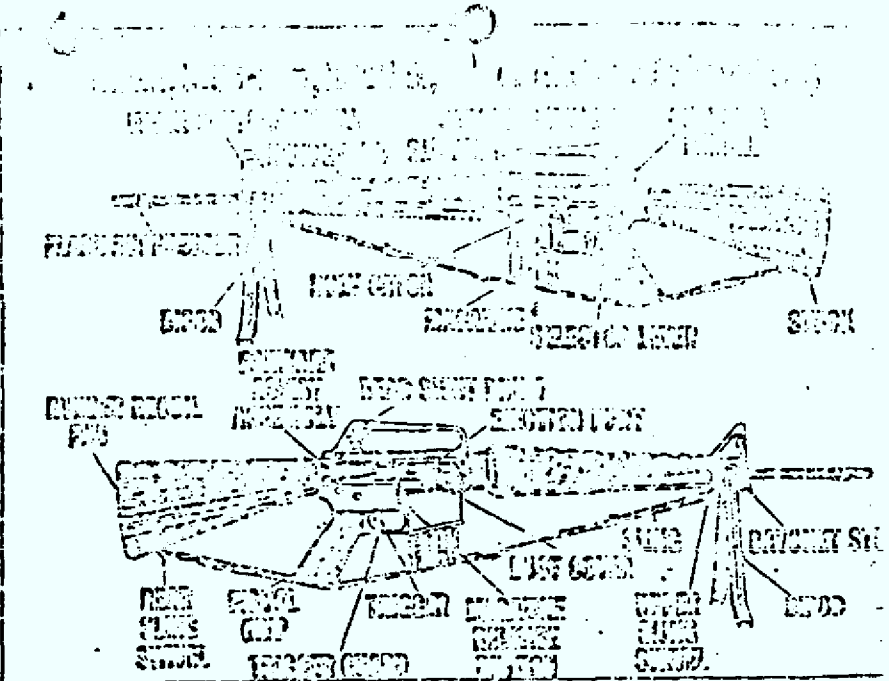
Being semi-automatic the M-16 can fire up to 45 to 65 rounds per minute. Fully automatic it shoots 60 to 800 rounds per minute. The maximum killing range is to 500 yards (500 yards is the length of a football field). Comparing the M-16 to the M-14, the M-16 fires 200 semi-automatic than the M-14 does fully automatic. The ammunition that the M-16 uses, 5.56 mm, also called 223 caliber, weighs half as much as the M-14's 7.62 mm NATO, that the M-14 shoots. The M-16's which the M-14's are twice as much. Therefore it is possible to carry twice as much M-16 ammunition.

The model that has been explained so far is the government military version. There is a commercial model that is still being sold in gun stores, although not in large quantities; it is called the AR-15. The only difference between the two is the AR-15 does not have a selector switch that enables you to change the fire from semi-automatic to automatic fire. The bolt of the AR-15 is not chrome-plated like the M-16, and the M-16 is made up of a heavy material, thus making it stand up to better combat conditions. The AR-15 is also lighter—its only weight 5 pounds. It sells for the price from \$250.00 to \$400.00 with a sniper scope mounted on the weapon. The weapon has a very light recoil; the barrel has a large spring in it called the "recoil spring", which absorbs a great deal of the recoil of the rifle, bringing the recoil down to as much as 1/3 of the recoil of the M-14. This weapon because of its high rate of fire is a perfect weapon for assault operations. Also it serves as an excellent defensive weapon with its large magazine capacity.

General Description

The M-16 is a gas operated magazine fed, air-cooled shoulder weapon. The magazine has a capacity of 20 rounds. When the M-16 was issued to the troops, it was...

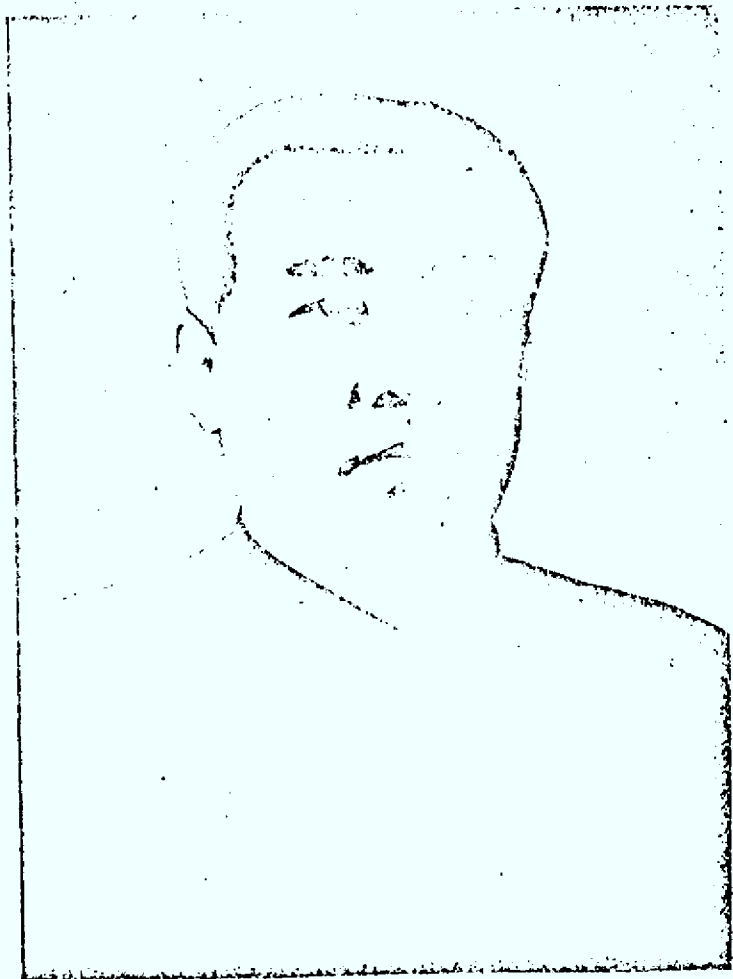

'A Match for a Hundred'--the militant slogan was put forward by the respected and beloved Leader Marshal Kim Il Sung for the officers and men of our People's Army.

On February 6, 1963, two days before the 15th anniversary of the founding of the glorious Korean People's Army, he visited our army unit which has risen to implement the decision of the historic Fifth Plenary Meeting of the Fourth Central Committee of our Party.

Our army unit outpost seethed with emotions and joy for his visit.

Marshal Kim Il Sung shook hands warmly with the masculine and courageous guards and looked around their barrack neatly built, saying:

"Marvellous! We have never built and lived in such a fine house on the hills as this, have we? The capitalists would live in this sort of house before..."

He highly praised our soldiers, saying that they knew how to live in a neat and cultured way. While looking around the positions, he repeatedly complimented us for our excellent success made in building up the outpost of the country into an impregnable fortress.

He did not bypass anything made by our soldiers and touched even a patch of grass on the wall of the trench to see whether it had rooted deep or not. He dropped into a shooting trench and took a posture of firing a heavy machine-gun.

"...You have built your positions very well!..."

"Our People's Army is well prepared politically and ideologically, and it can keep on fighting for ever with this kind of position..."

"You should plant more trees round the positions. If you plant many trees they are good for camouflage, and it isn't hot and you feel cool in the summer because they afford shade. How fine it would be! You can also use them as firewood.

"You should think of camouflage first of all when you build a house..."

After referring to every detail which we commanding personnel had not yet thought of and paid little attention to, Marshal Kim Il Sung taught us specific matters of principle with regard to combat organization commensurate to modern warfare.

He was walking slowly while having frank talks with

powder to his guerillas despite his hunger; he looked after his sleeping men at nights of howling storms and covered them with his overcoat. With his infinitely deep love and care, our guerillas fought the enemy undauntedly and won victory.

He went into the education room of the company and checked platoon leader's lecture materials and found out how the sergeant major looked after his soldiers.

Also he appreciated the instrumental ensemble performed by the red-flag company men, and encouraged them who were helping and pulling each other forward.

Touching the red-flag badge on the breast of a superior private, Marshall Kim Il Sung said as follows:

"...The army is a fine school.

"You should regard your service in the army as school education.

"In the army, you learn military and political affairs, learn a collective and disciplined life as well as general knowledge and how to lead a cultured life. What is most important is to learn the indomitable revolutionary spirit and collectivist spirit.

"How nice it is to help and pull up with each other! Only by doing this well, can your military and moral traits be cultivated more finely.

"That's why the red-flag company movement is important..."

After having a chat with soldiers at the outpost, the Leader repeatedly asked us commanders to conduct better the Party policy education, education of the revolutionary traditions, class education and education of socialist patriotism among the armymen.

Reminding us of the fact that the younger generation who had never seen landlords and capitalists came to take service in the army, he said that this younger generation was different from those who had waged the anti-Japanese armed struggle in the past or fought against the Yankees during the last war.

"The mere slogan of downing with landlords and capitalists was enough to embue the people of those days with irresistible hostility against the enemy.

"But the present-day young folks don't know what the landlords and capitalists are. So, you must not just shout slogans.

"You should bear this in mind.

"You should therefore conduct ideological education well with patience and arm them thoroughly with the revolutionary ideas of the working class.

"For a revolutionary army the foremost prerequisite to victory is to arm itself ideologically."

He continued to say that commanders should train their bodies, enhance their art of command decisively and equip themselves firmly with the new, ever-developing military science and technique.

"Don't think that you needn't learn any more because you have fought since the days of the anti-Japanese guerilla struggle, and don't rest content, thinking you can beat the enemy hands down, with the fact that you had advanced us far as the Rakdong River area fighting the Yankee bandits. We should make efforts to read more books in order to master new military science and technique.

"You should make a deep study of the enemy's weapons and strategy and tactics too. You can defeat the enemy when you know him.

"If the Yankees attack us again, we should annihilate them once and for all.

"To do so, each of you should be prepared to be a match for a hundred.

"A general who fought well has been called 'a match for a hundred,' from olden times. This means a man who is capable of beating a hundred enemies."

"...The solely correct way is to further strengthen the positions with the military personell you have now, conduct military training better and arm all the soldiers firmly with the revolutionary spirit so that each of them may match a hundred.

"The slogan of the People's Army is 'A Match for a Hundred.' "

His remarks reminded me of what he had once said during the period of the anti-Japanese armed struggle.

"...The legend says that in olden times men trained themselves in noted mountains to possess fighting spirit and military knowledge so as to become generals. In other words, they would become good generals if they made a profound study of military tech-

nique, sleeping on the snow in the depth of winter to train their physical strength, and living in the uninhabited forest and enduring solitude to steel their fighting spirit.

"This training of the legendary generals is no mystery for us..."

In those days we anti-Japanese guerillas, as told by him, developed our bodies and minds and improved combat capabilities and technique in far more arduous circumstances than the legendary generals trained themselves, so that we could annihilate and wipe out the Japanese imperialists who were superior in number everywhere.

We anti-Japanese guerillas under the leadership of Marshal Kim Il Sung won victory in the struggle against tens and hundreds of times bigger forces of the Japanese imperialist aggression army with small forces in very difficult conditions. This was, indeed, a great revolutionary struggle in which each one of us matched a hundred enemies.

I still remember the following remarks made by Marshal Kim Il Sung to us guerilla commanders at that time.

"...The Japanese imperialists now admit their impotence, raising a howl that they stand no chance against us even with ten Japanese soldiers against a guerilla or ten to one.

"But we must bear in mind clearly that if we lose one man in wiping out 100 enemy troops, this is no victory for us. Because the life of each guerilla is much more precious than 1,000 enemy troops since he has been seasoned in the guerilla struggle for many years and prepared politically and militarily and his sacrifice is an irrevocable loss.

"Therefore... we should always keep in mind that it is the principle of war, particularly the principle of guerilla warfare, to preserve our forces and annihilate large numbers of enemies without the sacrifice of a single man on our side..."

We anti-Japanese guerillas won victory, guided by these words of Marshal Kim Il Sung.

All of us constantly trained ourselves politically, ideologically, in military technique and physically with

That one will to accomplish the Korean revolution by our own efforts instead of relying on others. We anti-Japanese guerillas could always deal a hundred times, a thousand times heavier blows at the enemy, taking advantage of the natural fortresses in the northern border areas of Korea around Mt. Baekdu and the broader areas of northeast China.

That is why the Japanese imperialists who had made such tenacious and atrocious efforts to "annihilate" the anti-Japanese guerilla units by mobilizing the Kanto Army and massive regular armed forces in Korea, were forced at last to hold up their hands in despair, saying that "The Communist strategy and tactics are really strange. They wage war with 'tactics' which cannot be found in any book on military science. What is most difficult for us is that they resist us with the methods which have nothing in common with the operations conducted by the 'Imperial Army' in accordance with the combat regulations."

The idea of being a match for a hundred was already embodied in those difficult days of the anti-Japanese armed struggle organized and waged under the leadership of Marshal Kim Il Sung.

In fact, both in the period of the anti-Japanese armed struggle and in the Fatherland Liberation War under the wise leadership of Marshal Kim Il Sung, we annihilated the "strong" enemies who had boasted of their technical superiority, with our ideological and tactical superiority, each of us matching a hundred.

Indeed, the Korean revolutionaries have given fatal blows to the Japanese and U.S. imperialists, enemy No. 1 of our people, with the idea of being a match for a hundred ever since the period of the anti-Japanese armed struggle.

But the U.S. imperialists and their stooges doomed to final destruction are resorting to all means and methods to set up their manoeuvres for aggression and war provocation.

Marshal Kim Il Sung had made a penetrating analysis of the obtaining situation and taken measures for further enhancing our nation's defence capacities, before he gave his one-the-spot guidance to our unit.

What We Want What We Believe

1. We want freedom. We want power to determine the destiny of our Black Community.

We believe that black people will not be free until we are able to determine our destiny.

2. We want full employment for our people.

We believe that the federal government is responsible and obligated to give every man employment or a guaranteed income. We believe that if the white American businessmen will not give full employment, then the means of production should be taken from the businessmen and placed in the community so that the people of the community can organize and employ all of its people and give a high standard of living.

3. We want an end to the robbery by the CAPITALIST of our Black Community.

We believe that this racist government has robbed us and now we are demanding the overdue debt of forty acres and two mules. Forty acres and two mules was promised 100 years ago as restitution for slave labor and mass murder of black people. We will accept the payment in currency which will be distributed to our many communities. The Germans are now aiding the Jews in Israel for the genocide of the Jewish people. The Germans murdered six million Jews. The American racist has taken part in the slaughter of over fifty million black people; therefore, we feel that this is a modest demand that we make.

4. We want decent housing, fit for shelter of human beings.

We believe that if the white landlords will not give decent housing to our black community, then the housing and the land should be made into cooperatives so that our community, with government aid, can build and make decent housing for its people.

5. We want education for our people that exposes the true nature of this decadent American society. We want education that teaches us our true history and our role in the present-day society.

We believe in an educational system that will give to our people a knowledge of self. If a man does not have knowledge of himself and his position in society and the world, then he has little chance to relate to anything else.

6. We want all black men to be exempt from military service.

We believe that Black people should not be forced to fight in the military service to defend a racist government that does not protect us. We

7. We want an immediate end to POLICE BRUTALITY and MURDER of black people.

We believe we can end police brutality in our black community by organizing black self-defense groups that are dedicated to defending our black community from racist police oppression and brutality. The Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United States gives a right to bear arms. We therefore believe that all black people should arm themselves for self-defense.

8. We want freedom for all black men held in federal, state, county and city prisons and jails.

We believe that all black people should be released from the many jails and prisons because they have not received a fair and impartial trial.

9. We want all black people when brought to trial to be tried in court by a jury of their peer group or people from their black communities, as defined by the Constitution of the United States.

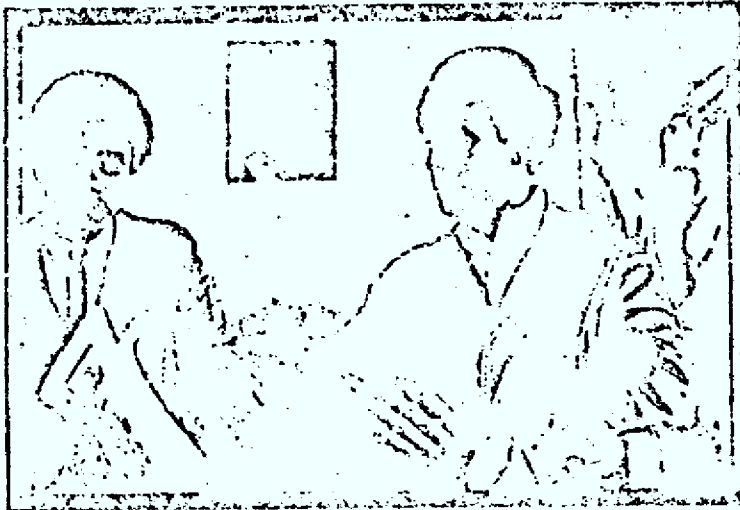
We believe that the courts should follow the United States Constitution so that black people will receive fair trials. The 14th Amendment of the U.S. Constitution gives a man a right to be tried by his peer group. A peer is a person from a similar economic, social, religious, geographical, environmental, historical and racial background. To do this the court will be forced to select a jury from the black community from which the black defendant came. We have been, and are being tried by all-white juries that have no understanding of the "average reasoning man" of the black community.

10. We want land, bread, housing, education, clothing, justice and peace. And as our major political objective, a United Nations-supervised plebiscite to be held throughout the black colony in which only black colonial subjects will be allowed to participate, for the purpose of determining the will of black people as to their national destiny.

When, in the course of human events, it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume, among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the laws of nature and nature's God entitle them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation.

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal: that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights: that among these are life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. That, to secure these rights, governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed: that, whenever any form of government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the right of the people to alter or to abolish it, and to institute a new government, laying its foundation on such principles, and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their safety and happiness. Prudence, indeed, will dictate that governments long established should not be changed for light and transient causes; and, accordingly, all experience hath shown, that mankind are more disposed to suffer, while evils are sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the forms to which they are accustomed. But, when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same object, evinces a design to reduce them under absolute despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such government, and to provide new guards for their future security.

[REDACTED] from conversation among BPP members, it was noted that when HEWETT was in Winston-Salem it was for some type of inspection, possibly concerning the recent ouster of some of the former BPP leaders in Winston-Salem. HEWETT apparently made the comment that JULY P. NEWTON is to be out on bond within two weeks and is to visit each BPP unit personally. (U)

MEMBER OF SUBJECT ORGANIZATION

[REDACTED] on that date there were approximately seventeen (17) individuals selling BPP newspapers, mostly in downtown Winston-Salem and at the Northside Shopping Center. LARRY LITTLE, DAVID CATO, BOBBY STOVER and ED McQUEEN were all selling papers at the Northside Shopping Center. With them was JAMES FORD, a prior member who is apparently back from some type restriction. It was also noted that McMillan's Minute Market and a store on Liberty Street called something like

"Mauney's Drug Store", along with the barber shop next to Hairston's Drug on Third Street, sell the BPP papers. (U)

[REDACTED] there were several articles in the most recent issue of the BPP paper concerning Winston-Salem and the article about BOBBY STOVER was written by ED McQUEEN. (U)

[REDACTED] newspaper salesmen are apparently going to High Point, Lexington, Thomasville and other cities to sell the papers. (U)

MEMBER OF [REDACTED] ORGANIZATION

[REDACTED] JAMES ACKERS, a BPP member formerly suspended for some infraction, is now back as a member and is selling BPP newspapers on the streets.

On July 23, 1970, SF T-22 reported that 3500 BPP newspapers were shipped to Winston-Salem and on July 30, 1970, SF T-22 reported that nine boxes of newspapers were shipped to Winston-Salem.

The following newspaper articles appeared in the July 11 and 18, 1970, issues of the BPP newspaper concerning Winston-Salem, North Carolina: ()

WINSTON-SALEM--ON CHICAGO STREET--

ALL THE PIGS DO IS COME BY AND COLLECT RENT

On Chicago Street in Winston-Salem, a section of Babylon on the East Side of town, are nothing but rat-infested shacks, where Black people have stayed over 10 years. No. 4 of our 10-Point Platform and Program says, "We want decent housing, fit for shelter of human beings."

When we went into the community to talk to people about these housing problems, one lady by the name of Helen said "these houses have never been repaired" since she has been living there. She also said "all they would do was to come by here to collect the rent. When we told the landlords or slumlords our houses needed repairs they would say O.K. and the next week they would be back for more rent, but still no repairs were performed." Most of these houses do not have hot water, or a bathtub. But when the end of the month or week comes the racist slumlord, the low-down racist dog is always there with their hands out for more rent.

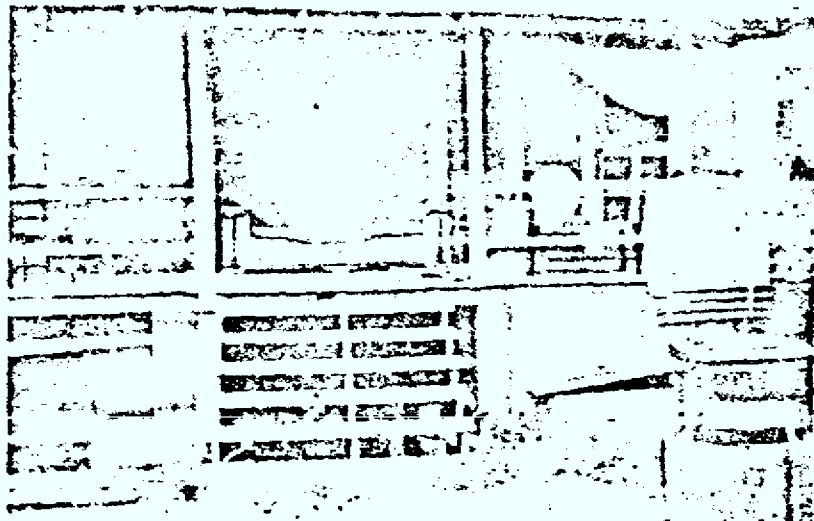
These houses are mostly rented by these two racist punks called "Newton Bros." and "L.F. Reeds and Son". These are the two biggest slumlords in Winston-Salem. We are now letting these two pigs know how the people in the community feel about them. The people in the community know that you are slumlords. But they didn't know how to deal with you until they were educated by the N.C.C.F.

The houses need to be taken from the hands of these two pigs and given to the people, because

they have stayed there long enough to have payed for these houses. These houses rent for \$8.00 to \$15.00 a week and we know that they are not good enough for that much money. Even the racist, dog-gish, pig knows this.

Everytime Reynolds gets a raise, the people's rent goes up. The food also goes up. These pigs are all joined hand and hand together all over the world to keep the people oppressed in the Black community. The same slumlord who owns

Black people throughout the world receive the worst of everything. The people are tired of being oppressed, and being forced to live like animals. They understand what the Platform and Program of the Party is all about, and they know that they are being denied what is rightfully theirs. So to all of the fascist, racist, oppressive forces (pigs) of the power structure, the people want you to know that they have put a time-limit on you. And it won't be long before that time

DRUGS AND THE BLACK COMMUNITY OF WINSTON SALEM

The ruling class pigs' apparatus for oppressing the people becomes less and less effective, because of the uncompromising desire of the poor and oppressed people to gain their liberation (by any means necessary). We see, therefore, an influx of drugs being sent into the communities of the poor and oppressed throughout this racist oppressive system, which we have seen is losing a genocidal war in Indochina, and is rapidly increasing its aims and objectives in another war, that war being the total genocide of Black people here in America. All throughout this sadistic, capitalistic nation from Black community to Black community, we are seeing that the youth as well as the older generation of our people are being systematically driven into a condition so dehumanizing that anything that will take them as far from reality as possible, becomes their only outlook. This escape from reality by the usage of drugs, leads to the inevitable--the user's death.

This genocidal attempt by the ruling class pigs has affected every Black community (as well as some white) in epidemic proportions. In most cases, Black people are the ones who are suffering most, because of their inability to be able to afford the high cost of drugs. This eventually leads to robbery by the user and his eventual incarceration.

In what once was a Winston-Salem far detached from the serious drug problems that every major city of most other states were experiencing, you can now stand on virtually any corner and watch as drugs are being distributed from the dealer to the pusher. In the more impoverished areas, the sight of a junkie nodding on a stoop or corner is becoming common-place.

In New York, as an example

of the genocidal effects of drugs upon our youth, over 700 Black people have died since January 1, 1970, in which the overwhelming majority have been under twenty-five years old, as compared to 900 deaths attributed to drug usage the whole year of 1969.

Drugs taken on a daily basis render a person totally incapable of controlling his thoughts or actions, and in most cases eventually lead to the death of the user.

Crime becomes the worry of the day, as the junkie is forced to steal (to support his costly chemical habit commonly known as a Jones). The community gets uptight, because the junkie lives with us, therefore, he is forced to steal from us. More pigs are sent into the community under the disguise of the need to help combat the soaring crime rate in the community, but in reality they are here to murder and brutalize as many people in the community as is piggishly possible. Jive rehabilitation programs set up by jive politicians do nothing but operate as pacification programs to keep the community unaware as to who is putting drugs in the community. Neither do these programs help remove the conditions that the junkie is trying to escape.

The Black Panther Party recognizes that only through the combined efforts of the Black community can we combat the plague. Any program to deal with the problems of our community should be run by the community. We must combine and double our efforts to stamp out this plague, and we will.

The following incident took place some time ago, but due to the racist nature of it we think it our duty to expose these acts whenever they occur. By gaining a true knowledge of our history, we can determine what course to take.

On December 21, 1969, Mr. Henry Martin Foy was picked up by the pigs, the racist dogs said that he was picked up for delivering whiskey in his car. He was charged with violating an old prohibition law. The brother went to court and was found guilty and the cost of court was \$300. The racist pigs also put him under a good behavior bond, which he had to pay \$10 a week until he paid \$1,000 (4 years), and if he wasn't caught with whiskey in his possession during this time, he would get his money back. But, he had only paid \$640.00, when he got ill and died. In case of his death, his wife and children were supposed to receive the money back. As of today June 1970, Mrs. Foy has been unable to get one penny of this stolen money.

Mrs. Foy has been trying to get the money that those racist dogs owe her. She went to lawyer Thin-

orton, thinking he would help her, but he came up with some phony crap that he would have to sue the judge. He later told her that he couldn't do it, and turned her over to racist dog Badger. He also told her the same thing that Thinorton told her, plus he said that the money would have to be given to support a school.

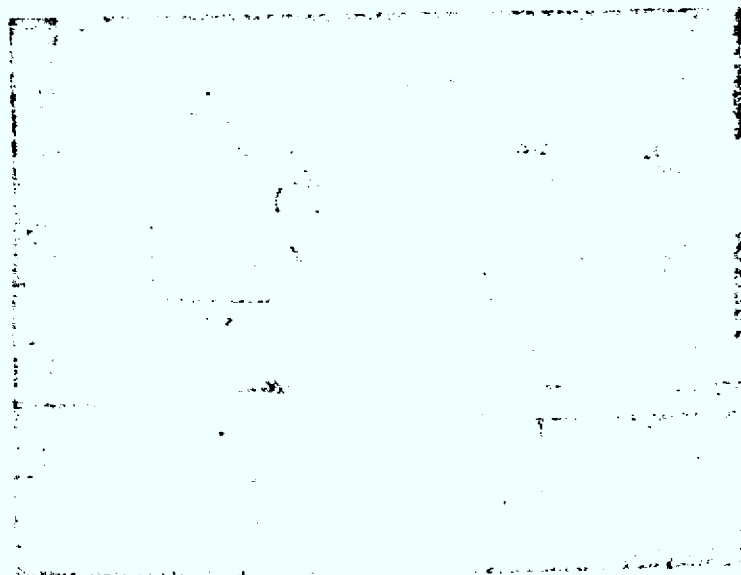

She really needs this money and racist pigs will not give it to her. No. 6 of our 10-Point Platform and Program states that: "We want all Black men to be exempt from military service," and that "We believe that Black people should not be forced to fight in a military service to defend a racist government that does not protect us."

On June 24, 1970, Brother Bobby Stover was at his home where his sisters live. He had just been discharged from the Marine Corp a couple of weeks before. As they sat talking, a car load of racist pigs drove up to his house with their guns drawn, ready to shoot. They said that they had a warrant stating that the F.B.I. was looking for him and also the Marine Corps. They never gave any reason why they were looking for him. Brother Bobby had his discharge papers with him stating that he had been discharged on June 5, 1970. Because of the racist nature of these blood thirsty goons, Brother Bobby was fortunate that he wasn't killed by these pigs.

This should prove to Black people that a Black man can have no peace or justice in this decadent society. The fact that Brother Bobby has fought for this country in a war for the benefit of the pigs, and when he gets

back home, these same pigs that he was protecting were ready and eager to murder him and his sisters. Luckily, Bobby was able to produce his papers or else more niggers would have been dead. There is at this time a clear attempt by the fascist dogs to rip off all the brothers who have come back from Vietnam because they possess valuable knowledge about guns and how to go about ripping off the oppressor.

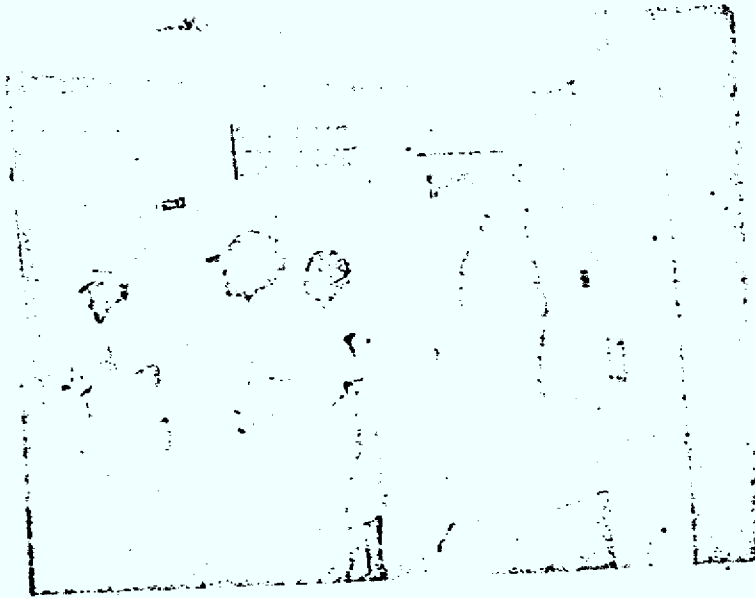

Last week, the N.C.C.F. received a call from Mary Ann Brooks, who is a Registered Nurse, employed by Kate Biting Reynolds Memorial Hospital, which owns the city. The sister was crying so, that she could hardly talk. She wanted to get over to the emergency room of the hospital because her stomach was killing her. So a sister and myself rushed over to her house at 1:00 am in the morning and drove her to the hospital, only to find three lackeys at the Registration Office ranting and raving. They said that the sister would have to have twelve dollars before she could see the doctor on duty. I told the workers that I would deal with all the necessary information needed, but to just let the sister see the doctor. The lackeys at the desk got angry with me because I demanded some medical attention for the sister. Someone else recognized Mary Brooks and said "it's alright, Miss Brooks is a nurse here." So I questioned the people in the office. I wanted to know why they placed money over the value of human life.

They began to run a lot of rhetoric about people should go see their private doctors at the sign of a headache or some other madness. The sister started blowing, trying to get them to see where they were exploiting the people, for the benefit of the greedy administrators. They were so hung up and tripping out, performing as lackeys, that they could not see the real oppressor.

Huey P. Newton teaches us that it is the lumpen that will be in the vanguard of the struggle. We see that this is true because those with a so-called education are simply being programmed to function as puppets in this decadent society. And it is clear that they want nothing changed. If you control a nigger's mind, you con-

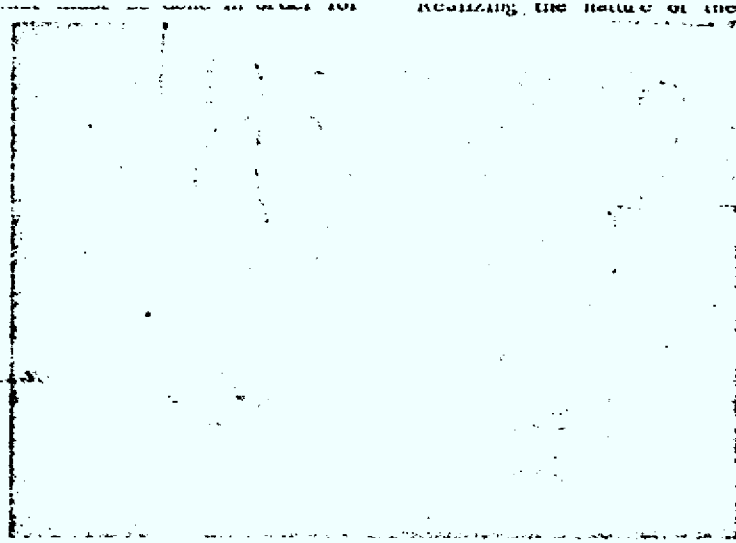
trol his body. The lackeys have minds, so therefore they find themselves being manipulated by the administrators. The lumpen still have their minds to some extent, and therefore cannot be used by the oppressor.

Anytime people put the value of money over the life of any human being, we see this society as being sick. It's just a case of mind over matter, if the people don't mind, then the pigs don't matter.

On the set today in Babylon, the pigs are running in the red. At one time these foul depraved traders would attempt to camouflage their fascist tactics, in these days and times, the pigs don't try to hide a thing. They simply break into your house in the wee hours of the morning and murder you in your bed asleep or send 500 pigs into your pad or office with machine guns and all other tools of warfare on a "search and destroy mission." We shouldn't get up-right because the mass media paints us utterly black because of the way we move to win our freedom, when we Black people move to throw off the shackles of slavery by any means necessary. It is time for Black people to realize that the oppressor has no rights in which the oppressed Black people are bound to respect. Later for all the puppet journalists, we've criticized them enough with words, it is high time that we criticize them with weapons. And there won't be anything wrong with that because for we, poor, oppressed Black people, who have been wronged for so long, we will be wronged no more.

Only on the bones of the oppressor can the people have self-rule.

Review of the [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Winston-Salem, as compared with the list of recognized chapters and branches and NCCFs of the BPP as it appears in the June 27, 1970, issue of the BPP newspaper, page 22, indicates the group at Winston-Salem was in contact with other BPP groups in California, New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, Massachusetts, Maryland and Washington, D. C.

**BLACK PANTHER PARTY,
Also Known As
Black Panther Party for Self-Defense**

According to its official newspaper, the Black Panther Party (BPP) was started during December, 1966, in Oakland, California, to organize black people so they can take control of the life, politics and the destiny of the black community. It was organized by Bobby Seale, BPP Chairman, and Huey P. Newton, BPP Minister of Defense. Newton was sentenced in 1968 to serve 2 to 15 years after being convicted of manslaughter, in connection with the killing of an Oakland police officer.

The official newspaper, "The Black Panther," which further describes itself as the "Black Community News Service," states that the BPP advocates the use of guns and guerrilla tactics in its revolutionary program to end oppression of the black people. Residents of the black community are urged to arm themselves against the police who are consistently referred to in the publication as "pigs" who should be killed.

"The Black Panther" issue of September 7, 1968, contains an editorial by BPP Minister of Education, George Mason Murray, which ends with the following:

"Black men. Black people, colored persons of America, revolt everywhere! Arm yourselves. The only culture worth keeping is a revolutionary culture. Change. Freedom everywhere. Dynamite! Black Power. Use the gun. Kill the pigs everywhere."

Included in the introduction to an article appearing in the October 5, 1968, edition of "The Black Panther" is the statement "...we will not dissent from American Government. We will overthrow it."

Issues of "The Black Panther" regularly contain quotations from the writings of Chairman Mao Tse-tung of the People's Republic of China and feature Mao's statement that "political power grows out of the barrel of a gun."

The national headquarters of the BPP is located at 3106 Shattuck Avenue, Berkeley, California. Branches have been established at various locations throughout the United States.

The following is a summary of BPP activities within the
Charlotte Division during July, 1970:

In connection with the BPP Newspaper the group continues
to receive it on a weekly basis and sell it on the streets of
Winston-Salem, N. C., and other areas. Numerous articles continue
to appear in the paper by-lined Winston-Salem referring critically
to various situations in Winston Salem.

The group continues to have financial problems and
telephone company has disconnected telephone number 919-722-4097,
which was located at their 1602 East 14th St. address. This was
for nonpayment of account; however, ████████████████████ they
apparently continue to have sufficient funds to support the members
and pay their rent.

On 7/28/70, [REDACTED] and five other individuals, not known to be Panther members, were arrested for disorderly conduct while putting up BPP posters at Winston-Salem. [REDACTED] it was decided [REDACTED] to hold rallies at the Forsyth County Courthouse during the trials of these six individuals, which will be held during the period 8/12-25/70.

The weekly political education classes for non-members have continued along with the liberation school which is attended by children from ages four to ten during the mornings.

There continues to be some dissatisfaction over the rigorous discipline and the leadership of LARRY DONNELL LITTLE and this is believed to be the reason that WILLIAM RANDOLPH RICE has discontinued his affiliation with the group.

[REDACTED] has not been observed recently in Winston-Salem and was last known to be working on the Repressed Peoples Constitutional Convention which is to be held at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, during September, 1970. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] has been transferred out of Winston-Salem and has left Winston-Salem; however, her exact location has not been reported.

RAYMOND "MASI" HEWITT accompanied by other individuals, whose identities were not known, toured the headquarters of the Winston-Salem National Committee to Combat Fascism during the first part of July, 1970. This was believed [REDACTED] to be an inspection trip in connection with the recent ouster of the previous leadership.
