WORK HANDLED BY UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES
DURING FISCAL YEAR 1962

CRIMINAL CASES

FILED - Criminal cases filed increased by 1,120 or 3.6 per cent to 31,911. About 56 per cent or 16,995 of these cases were in the following seven offenses.

Increases took place in 53 districts ranging from 259 in Southern Florida to 1 in Northern Georgia while decreases ranging from 206 in Southern California to 2 in both Northern Alabama and Northern Oklahoma occurred in 38 districts.

TERMINATED - Although less in number than cases filed the 31,017 terminated showed an increase of 708 or 2.3 per cent over fiscal year 1961's total of 30,309. Of the 31,017 cases, 22,817 (having 27,733 defendants) were closed after guilty pleas; 2,613 (involving 3,365 defendants) were found guilty after trial and 833 (with 1,403 defendants) not guilty.

PENDING - With 9,348 cases the pending criminal caseload as of June 30, 1962 showed an increase of 10.6 per cent over the 8,454* cases pending at the close of the previous fiscal year. 7,790 were in a triable status while 1,558 cases were in a fugitive or other status beyond the control of United States Attorneys.

GRAND JURY PROCEEDINGS

Grand Jury Proceedings comprised of 15,285 indictments and 541 No True Bills amounted to 15,826 a rise of 4.8 per cent from the 15,100 such proceedings in fiscal year 1961.

CRIMINAL COMPLAINTS

RECEIVED - Complaints received in United States Attorneys' offices increased to 111,928, the largest number for the past 10 fiscal years and 4.1 per cent more than the 107,559** received in fiscal year 1961. Southern California with 7,656 had the most complaints. Southern Florida with 4,642 and New Jersey with 3,989 were next highest.

CLOSED - 78,084 complaints were closed during fiscal year 1962 without reaching court dockets. Of this number 69,665 with 88,501 defendants were closed by declination of prosecution.

PENDING - Criminal complaints pending as of June 30, 1962 amounted to 11,959, a 16.6 per cent increase over the 10,255 pending as of June 30, 1961.

CIVIL SUITS

FILED - Civil suits filed by aggregating 25,242 reached an all time high in fiscal year 1962. This was 5.7 per cent more than the 23,877 filed in the previous fiscal year. A total of 47 districts had increases; one had the same number and 43 had decreases. Twelve districts with

filings ranging from 548 to 1,257 accounted for 43.1 per cent or 10,876 of the total cases filed. Negotiable instrument cases with 3,710 and Veterans' cases with 2,616 decreased by 212 and 256 cases respectively while Tax cases with 7,082 increased by 1,002.

TERMINATED - With 43 districts showing increases, civil suits terminated rose from 22,271 to 22,899 an increase of 2.8 per cent. Increases ranged from 233 in Southern Florida to 1 in Middle Tennessee while decreases ranged from 201 in Kansas to 1 in Maine and Eastern Louisiana. 1,142 of these cases were suits in which the government as defendant was sued for \$71,386,414. 598 of them involving \$27,070,865 were closed by compromises amounting to \$5,215,819 and 248 involving \$19,101,496 resulted in judgments against the government amounting to \$8,725,017. The remaining 242 suits involving \$25,214,053 were won by the Government thus bringing the savings to \$57,445,578 an increase of \$16,093,387 or 38.9 per cent over the \$41,352,191 saved in fiscal year 1961.

PENDING - The backlog of civil pending as of the close of the fiscal year again showed an increase over the number pending at the close of the previous fiscal year. As of June 30, 1962 civil suits pending rose to 22,919 an 11.4 per cent increase over the 20,576 pending as of June 30, 1961. 12,331 or 53.8 per cent were in 18 districts with caseloads ranging from 405 in Eastern Michigan to 1,195 in Southern Florida. Tax Lien cases amounting to 4,385 comprised 19.1 per cent of the total. Lands cases including 3,071 Condemnation cases aggregated 3,639 or 15.9 per cent of the total.

CIVIL MATTERS

RECEIVED - Civil matters received reached an all time high of 35,143 and thus showed an increase of 6.9 per cent over the 32,888 received in fiscal year 1961. Negotiable instrument matters with 7,438 and Veterans' matters with 4,176 comprised 21.2 per cent and 11.9 per cent of the total respectively. 11,974 or 34.1 per cent of the total were in 8 districts having totals ranging from 1,122 in New Jersey to 2,511 in Eastern New York.

TERMINATED - Civil matters terminated without reaching court dockets amounted to 8,211 an increase of 231 over the previous fiscal year.

PENDING - 14,642 civil matters were pending as of June 30, 1962 as compared to 12,931 as of June 30, 1961. This is an increase of 1,711 or 13.2 per cent.

COLLECTIONS

Collections for fiscal year 1962 exceeded \$50,000,000 for the first time in the history of the department as they amounted to \$52,686,047, an increase of 51.2 per cent over the \$34,837,720 collected in fiscal year 1961. This total is \$10,651,259 more than the previous high set in fiscal year 1956 when \$42,034,788 was collected. This year's amount represents a return of \$3.61 for each dollar of the \$14,613,400 appropriated for United States Attorneys' offices for the year ending June 30, 1962.

PERSONNEL

During the year United States Attorneys' employment averaged 1,581 employees; 641 employees were appointed and 477 separated a net gain

of 164 employees, and 1,642 employees were on the rolls as of June 30, 1962. Cases handled per Assistant United States Attorney increased from 144 in fiscal year 1961 to 149.4 in the current fiscal year while cases terminated rose from 93.1 to 93.5.

CASES PENDING IN UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES




CHART NO. 2

Thousands of Cases



TOTAL 9,348 CASES




CHART NO. 4

TOTAL 9,348 CASES



TOTAL 9,348 CASES



CRIMINAL CASES FILED




CHART NO. 7
CRIMINAL CASES FILED




CHART NO. 8
PROCEEDINGS BEFORE GRAND JURY



CRIMINAL CASES TERMINATED



TRIALS IN CRIMINAL CASES



U. S. CIVIL SUITS PENDING




CHART NO. 12

TOTAL 22,919 SUITS




CHART NO. 13

TOTAL 22,919 SUITS





CHART NO. 14

CIVIL CASES FILED



CIVIL MATTERS RECEIVED




CHART NO. 17
CIVIL SUITS TERMINATED



APPROPRIATIONS AND COLLECTIONS



ACCESSIONS AND SEPARATIONS - UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES



