WORK HANDLED BY UNITED STATES ATTORNEY'S OFFICES
DURING FISCAL YEAR 1978

CRIMINAL CASES

FILED - Criminal filings amounting to 35,023 showed a decrease of 3,429 or 8.92 percent less than the number filed in the previous fiscal year. 68.87 percent of the total was in 13 offenses having 700 or more cases. The greatest volume of filings were in Controlled Substances (4,443), Weapons Control (3,077), Frauds vs/Government (3,044), Postal Crimes (2,782), Immigration (1906), Bank Robbery (1,703), Income Tax (1,623), Stolen Property (943), and National Motor Vehicle Act (791). Increases took place in 32 districts ranging from 1 in North Carolina Middle to 289 in Georgia Middle. Decreases took place in 72 districts ranging from 4 in Guam and Vermont to 838 in Georgia Southern.

TERMINATED - Cases terminated decreased 5,525 or 13.41 percent less than the previous year's total. Of the total or 35,704 closed, 21,587 involving 27,364 defendants were pleas of guilty, 3,059 (involving 4,412 defendants) were found guilty after trial and 786 (involving 1,401 defendants) were found not guilty (including 13 not guilty verdicts by reason of insanity).

PENDING - With 23,253 cases, the pending caseload showed a decrease of 2.85 percent less than the 23,934* cases pending at the close of fiscal year 1977. Of the pending cases, 8,929 cases were awaiting arraignment in court or trial, while 1,919 were awaiting sentence. 5,623 are fugitives and 288 in other status beyond the control of the United States Attorneys.

GRAND JURY PROCEEDINGS

Grand Jury Proceedings, comprised of 19,405 indictments and 104 No True Bills, amounted to 19,509, a decrease of 9.40 percent less than the previous fiscal year.

CRIMINAL COMPLAINTS

RECEIVED - Complaints received decreased to 152,101 or 4.04 percent less than the 158,501 received in fiscal year 1977. California Southern with 30,567 had the most complaints and Illinois Northern with 5,432 and New Jersey with 4,330 were the next highest. 69,485 of the complaints were in eleven offenses as shown below:

PENDING - Criminal complaints pending as of September 30, 1978 rose to 35,888 an increase of 717 or 2.04 percent more than the 35,171 pending as of September 30, 1977.

CLOSED - 116,361 complaints were closed during 1978 without reaching court dockets. Of this number 100,773 or 86.60 percent of the total were closed by declination of prosecution.

CIVIL CASES

FILED - Civil cases filed amounted to 50,097 an increase of 1,669 or 3.44 percent more than the previous year's total. 60 districts had increases and 34 districts showed decreases from the previous year. 18,585 or 37.10 percent of the total was in thirteen districts having filings ranging from 1132 to 2,149, Tax Lien cases with 6,056, Torts cases with 2,931 and General Claims cases with 5,054 had 12.09, 5.85 and 10.09 percent respectively of the cases filed.

TERMINATED - With 59 districts showing increases and 33 districts with decreases, civil cases terminated increased to 43,973. This total is over fiscal year 1977 total by 3,875 or 9.66 percent.

7,813 of these cases were suits in which the Government as defendant was sued for \$689,733,491. 748 of them involving \$243,680,949 were closed by compromise amounting to \$8,460,140 and 1,339 involving \$65,442,442 resulting in judgments against the Government amounting to \$9,387,036. The remaining 5,726 cases involving \$380,610,100 were won by the Government, thus bringing the savings to \$666,728,978 a decrease of \$28,993,632 or 4.17 percent less than the \$695,722,610 saved in fiscal year 1977.

PENDING - Civil cases pending as of the close of the fiscal year increased by 6,124 or 9.35 percent to 71,552. 39,860 or 55.71 percent of the caseload was in twenty districts with caseloads ranging from 1,082 in Pennsylvania Middle to 4,517 in New York Eastern. Tax Lien cases with 10,150 increased to 14.18 percent of the total as compared to 9,550 or 13.93 percent of the total pending as of September 30, 1977. Torts cases with 5,971 or 8.35 percent increased from 5,670 or 8.64 percent of the total.

CIVIL MATTERS

RECEIVED - Civil matters received amounted to 73,380 an increase of 16,910 or 29.94 percent more than the 56,470 in fiscal year 1977. Tax Lien matters with 6,131 and Torts

matters with 3,073 comprised 8.36 percent and 4.19 percent respectively of the total. Delegated General Claims matters amounted to 16,397 or 22.35 percent of the total. 38,978 or 53.12 percent of the total was in twenty-three districts having totals ranging from 1,036 in Alabama Northern to 3,470 in California Central.

TERMINATED - Civil matters terminated without reaching court dockets amounted to 7,113 an increase of 1,640 or 30.00 percent more than the fiscal year 1977 total of 5,473.

PENDING - 30,604 civil matters were pending as of September 30, 1978 as compared to 14,434 as of September 30, 1977. This is an increase of 16,170 or 112.03 percent.

HOURS IN COURT

A total of 502,175 hours were spent in court during fiscal year 1978. This is a decrease of 7,034 or 2.38 percent less than fiscal year 1977. Following is a breakdown of those hours:

Based on an average employment of 1415.6 each Assistant United States Attorney averaged 29.56 hours per month in courtroom work during the fiscal year. This compares with an average of 30.61 hours per month in fiscal year 1977.

COLLECTIONS

Collections for fiscal year 1978 amounted to \$215,195,910, a decrease of \$1,536,992 or .71 percent less than the \$216,732,902 collected in fiscal year 1977.

PERSONNEL

During the year United States Attorneys' employment averaged 3,346 employees and 3,341 were on the rolls as of September 30, 1978. Cases handled per Assistant United States Attorney decreased from 125.7 in fiscal year 1977 to 123.2 in the current year while cases terminated decreased from 58.8 to 56.2.



United States Attorneys' Offices**




Chart 3 | Criminal and Civil Cases Terminated in United States Attorney's Offices




Chart 4 | Criminal and Civil Matters Received in United States Attorneys' Offices






Chart 5 | Trials in Criminal and Civil Cases in United States Attorneys' Offices

Total 23,253




Chart 8 | Criminal Cases Filed in United States Attorneys' Offices






Chart 9 | Proceedings Before Grand Jury in United States Attorneys' Offices




**Chart 10 | Age of Criminal and Civil Cases Pending in

Total Cases Criminal 23,253 Civil 71,552




**Chart 11 | Civil Cases Pending in

Total 71,552 Cases




**Chart 12 | Civil Cases Pending
