  - Vending machine count
  - Thermostat settings







## Fire Station Sustainability Upgrades

- Advanced Assessments
  - HVAC
  - Building envelop
  - Maintenance procedures
- Project Prioritization
  - Payback
  - Initial investment
  - Co-Benefits
    - Indoor air quality, comfort, decreased maintenance
