

Bird Impact Data from DOI-ERDC Database Download 12 Oct. 2010

These verified data are a proportion of the total unverified data in the daily reports.

The Service is working as quickly as possible to review all of data in order to match up the verified numbers with the unverified numbers reported daily. However, there will continue to be a gap in the two sets of data as the quality assurance/quality control process is completed, which takes one to two weeks for each bird.

Based on our experience with oil spills and the behavior of migratory birds, we expect that the number of oiled birds collected may represent only a portion of the total birds affected by the spill. We are addressing these and other injury-related issues through our ongoing NRDA studies.
