


New CDC Resources to Promote Vaccines for Preteens and Teens

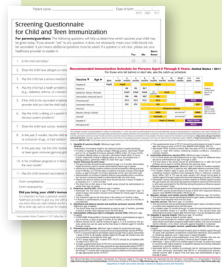

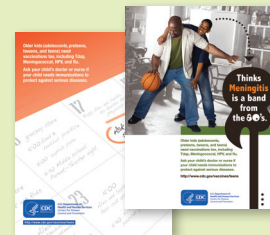

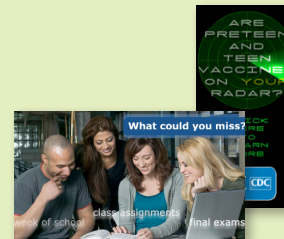
