SUBJECT: Leadership Training for Combating Trafficking in Persons

Department of Defense (DoD) Leadership must understand their role in ensuring that their subordinates comply with laws and departmental policies regarding Trafficking in Persons (TIP). DoD Instruction 2200.01, "Combating Trafficking in Persons (CTIP)," dated February 16, 2007, states: "It is DoD policy to educate all Service members and DoD civilians annually on the worldwide trafficking menace, national TIP policy, overseas theater TIP policy, and attendant personal responsibilities consistent with DoD core values and ethical standards."

To assist leaders in carrying out their responsibilities as outlined in DoDI 2200.01, the department has developed a Leadership training module on TIP. The leadership module reviews general TIP awareness training; sets out operating procedures; and describes actual TIP stories from the field. TIP awareness training is mandatory for all DoD personnel. The Leadership training module reinforces the general training and provides updated information. The training will be available on the Advanced Distributed Learning on-line version for global distribution in April 2008. The web site for active duty military is http://jko.cmil.org.
