ORDER

Pursuant to the Rules of Professional Conduct, 8 C.F.R. §§ 1003.102(e)(1) and 1003.106(b), Respondent is hereby suspended from the practice of law before the Board of Immigration Appeals, the Immigration Courts, and the Department of Homeland Security, for a period of two (2) years, effective September 25, 2003. Respondent may seek reinstatement under the restrictions set forth in 8 C.F.R. §1003.107 provided that, at the time of the filing of the reinstatement petition, Respondent meets the definition of attorney at 8 C.F.R. §1.1(f).

Respondent has the right to appeal this decision to the Board of Immigration Appeals pursuant to 8 C.F.R. § 1003.106(c). A notice of appeal must be filed in accordance with all pertinent provisions for appeals to the Board, including provision relating to forms and fees, as set forth in 8 C.F.R. Part 3.


