

Before the next disaster occurs, make sure you are ready. Build an emergency supply kit that includes the following:

- Water (at least a gallon per person daily)
- High-energy foods: nuts, raisins & granola
- Canned meats, fruits & vegetables
- Manual can opener
- Baby formula, food & supplies
- Cereal, crackers & cookies
- Matches (in waterproof container)
- Paper cups, plates & utensils
- Toilet paper & moist wipes
- Pet food & supplies
- Over-the-counter medications
- First-aid kit & hand sanitizer
- Plastic storage containers
- Soap, detergent, disinfectant & bleach
- Batteries
- Garbage bags
- Flashlight
- Candles
