New! e-NOTAM Website

The electronic NOTAM (e-NOTAM) system is now available to all airports authorized to issue NOTAMs in the United States (excluding Alaska).

The e-NOTAM system is a web-based NOTAM notification method that lets user enter NOTAM information directly into a web page form and transmit the information to a NOTAM specialist at Flight Service. It eliminates wait times that you have when you use a telephone to call in NOTAMs, call to see if faxed NOTAMs were received, or call to see if NOTAMs were issued.

The e-NOTAM System does **not** interface with the U. S. NOTAM System. When you enter NOTAM information in the online form, a Flight Service Specialist will get it and process the NOTAM for entry to the U.S. NOTAM System. After you submit your data, you can check the "NOTAM HISTORY" display of the eNOTAM System for NOTAM status and number. You can choose to have the same information emailed to you.

Use of the e-NOTAM System is voluntary. You may still use the toll-free NOTAM phone number: 877-4US-NTMS (877-487-6867).

To use the e-NOTAM process, go to the web site select the "Request Access" menu link. Follow the simple instructions. The Lockheed Martin Flight Services Program Office will verify your authority and send an e-mail with further instructions and a username and password to get you started.
