Notice Regarding Application of Certain Local Bankruptcy Rules September 4, 2012

In anticipation of changes to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure to permit greater use of electronic records on appeal, the district court has determined that the procedures stated below apply:

LBR 8006.1 Duty of Bankruptcy Clerk to Include Copies of Items in the Record; Preparation and Transmittal of Duplicate Volume of these Copies.

The requirement of LBR 8006.1(a) that the clerk of the bankruptcy court prepare a separate volume of the record on appeal is waived. The presiding district judge will notify the clerk of the bankruptcy court to prepare such a volume if it is needed in a particular appeal.

LBR 8006.2 Duty of Parties to Provide Copies of Items for Inclusion in the Record.

This rule is waived as to each document available in the ECF system.

LBR 8006.3 Duty of Bankruptcy Clerk When Party Fails to Provide Copies of Designated Items; Prepayment Requirement.

This rule is waived as to each document available in the ECF system.

LBR 8006.6 Release, Circulation, and Return of Record on Appeal.

LBR 8006.6(a), (b), (c), (d), and (e) are waived as to each document available in the district court ECF system.
