

## Overview


- The U.S. economy continues to recover, but at a very modest pace
  - But there remain considerable risks
- Employment growth is thin, in the U.S. and in Kansas, and by some measures, its worse than we think it is
- Kansas has some economic advantages that have mitigated the national economic doldrums

## Annual Growth in Real GDP





## Quarterly Real GDP Growth (Annualized)




# FOMC Real GDP Growth Forecast

(September, 2012)






## Retail Spending (Tenth Federal Reserve District, incl. Kansas)





## Three-Month-Ahead Retail Outlook (Tenth Federal Reserve District, incl. Kansas)



## Average Debt per Consumer




## Average Debt per Consumer (excludes first mortgage)

At least 30 days past due












## Unemployment Rates



#### Job Growth by Industry August, 2011 – August, 2012




## Aircraft Manufacturing Employment






## Production Indexes for the Tenth District



## Agriculture Exports





## Expanded Unemployment Rate



## The Fiscal Cliff (Current Projection 2013 is 2.5% - 3.0%)





## Federal Debt (% of GDP)
















