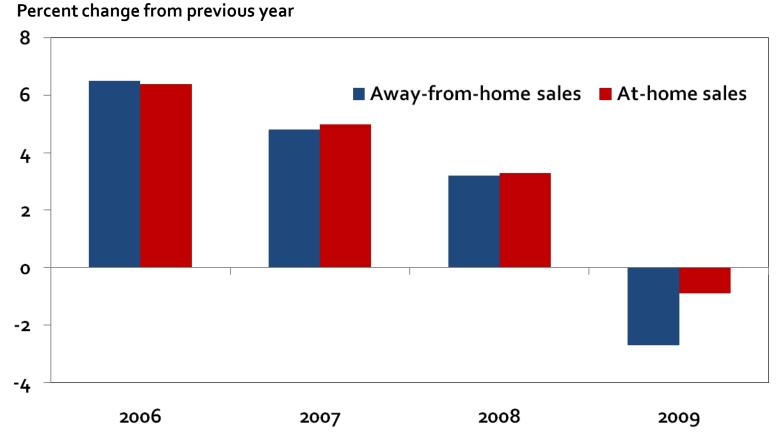

Food sales decline, especially at restaurants.



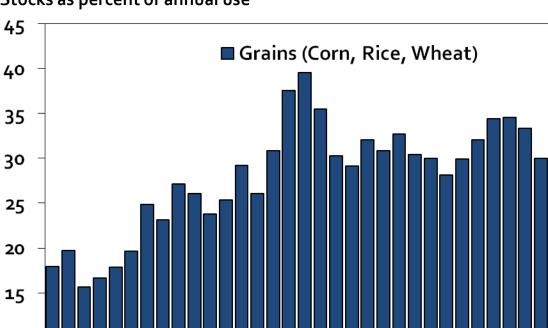

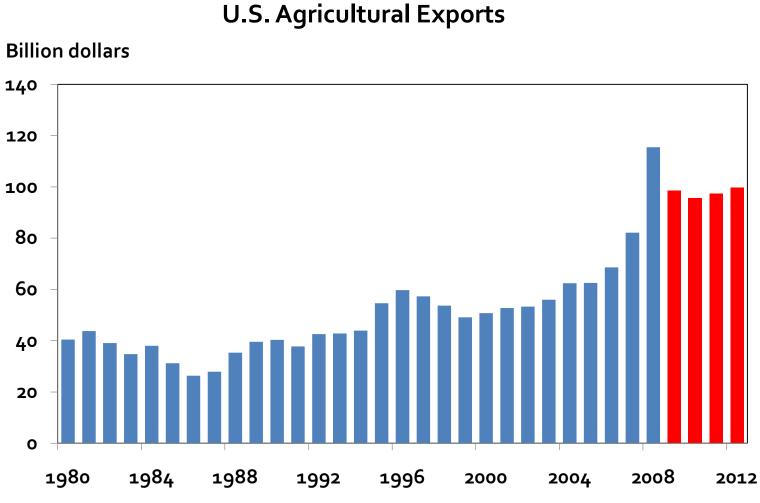

Can exports underpin the ag economy?

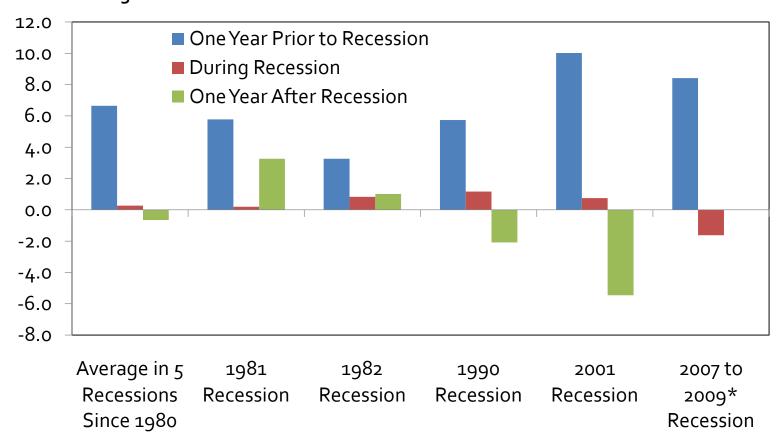

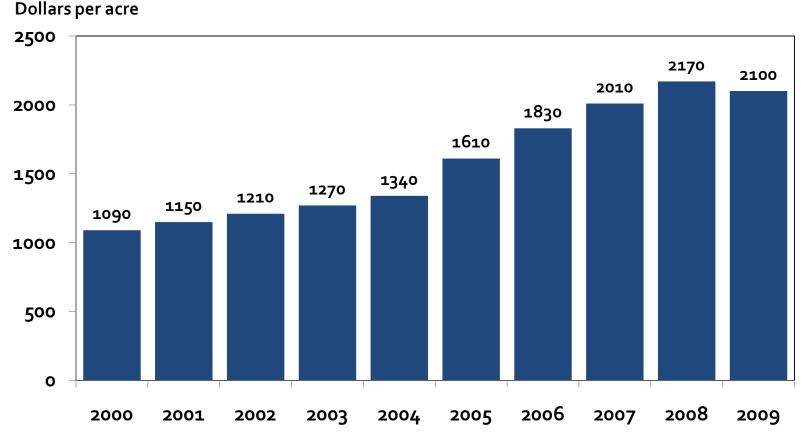
