

On September 17th and 18th, a DLA recruiter participated in the DisAbility Jobs Summit. The recruitment event was sponsored by the Ohio Rehabilitation Services Commission (RSC) and was held at the Greater Columbus Convention Center in Columbus, Ohio. The focus of the job fair and conference was to connect and build partnerships by meeting the informational and training needs of the disabled Ohioans, employment service professionals, and partners in the government and business sectors. This summit was dedicated to expanding and improving the employability of unemployed and underemployed groups. The conference included training for government leadership agencies, Ohio's business sectors, vocational services providers, and consumer groups/employment seekers.
