## VISITOR INFORMATION

- Visitors are required to bring a printed copy of their visitor ticket and a government-issued photo ID such as a driver's license or passport. The name on the ID and visitor ticket must match.
- All visitors and bags are subject to security screening.
- Limit the number of belongings you bring to the museum; bag storage is not available.
- Taking pictures or videos is not allowed in any part of the building.

## GUIDED TOUR TIPS

- Tours can be booked as far as three months in advance. Schedule online as early as possible.
- Space is limited; large groups may need to break up into smaller groups and book adjacent tour time slots.
- High school groups must have one teacher/adult supervisor for every eight students.
- Students who are part of a school group must be at least 16 years old or juniors in high school.
- Arrive about 20 minutes before your scheduled tour to allow time to go through security. Tours won't be held for late visitors.
- If you want to spend time viewing special exhibits, we recommend arriving an hour before your scheduled tour.
