ELECTION OF DIRECTORS REPORT OF NOMINATIONS—VOTING PROCEDURES

To All Member Banks in the Eleventh Federal Reserve District:

In accordance with the provisions of Section 4 of the Federal Reserve Act and the announcement dated August 7, 2012, in regard to the election of directors of this Bank to succeed Pete Cook, Class A Director, and Margaret H. Jordan, Class B Director, whose terms expire December 31, 2012, the names of the candidates nominated for such directorships and the names of the banks that made the nominations are set out on pages 3 through 5.

I also enclose for each bank in Group 1 a ballot for use in voting for a Class B Director and for each bank in Group 3 a ballot for use in voting for a Class A Director. An envelope bearing on its face the certificate in regard to the vote and an envelope marked "Ballot," in which the ballot is to be sealed, are also provided. The ballot and certificate on the envelope must be executed by an officer who has been authorized to cast the vote. To ensure the confidentiality of the balloting, please do not write the name of the bank or of the voting officer on the ballot but only on the certificate envelope. When several banks are subsidiaries of a bank holding company,* **the voting forms are being sent only to the bank designated to participate in this election;** therefore, banks in Groups 1 and 3 that will not participate in this election are being sent this notice, without forms, only for their information.

Please follow carefully the instructions that are printed on the ballot and the certificate envelope.

The following procedure is required in the case of both the Class A and Class B ballots:

- (1) The ballot should be marked.
- (2) It should then be placed in the envelope marked "Ballot" and the envelope sealed.
- (3) After the certificate on the certificate envelope is executed, the sealed ballot envelope should be placed within the certificate envelope.
- (4) The sealed certificate envelope containing the sealed ballot envelope should then be returned to me in the enclosed self-addressed envelope.

Under the law, the ballot must be returned to me within 15 days after its receipt. The polls will open on October 3, 2012, and close at 2 p.m. on October 18, 2012. At that time, the ballots will be opened, the votes counted, and the results of the election announced.

*Section 4 of the Federal Reserve Act, as amended, reads in part as follows:

"...That whenever any member banks within the same Federal Reserve district are subsidiaries of the same bank holding company within the meaning of the Bank Holding Company Act of 1956, participation in any such nomination or election by such member banks, including such bank holding company if it is also a member bank, shall be confined to one of such banks, which may be designated for the purpose by such holding company."

The Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System has ruled that a holding company affiliate, having one or more subsidiary banks in each of the three groups into which member banks of a Federal Reserve district are divided for the purpose of electing directors, may designate one such bank in each group to participate in the nomination and election of each Class A Director and each Class B Director chosen by the group of which such bank is a member and such member bank so designated may validly participate in such nomination and election. Accordingly, banks in Groups 1 and 3 affected by the foregoing provision of law are requested to take prompt action to have the appropriate bank holding company designate, if it has not already designated, one of such banks to participate in this election.

While the banks in Group 2 will not vote in this election, this notice is sent to them, without forms, for their information. Group 2 consists of member banks with combined capital and surplus of over \$3,500,000 but under \$15,000,000.

IMPORTANT

For your information, there is quoted below an extract from Section 4 of the Federal Reserve Act that sets forth the method of balloting:

"Within fifteen days after receipt of the list of candidates the duly authorized officer of a member bank shall certify to the chairman his first, second, and other choices for director of Class A or Class B, respectively, upon a preferential ballot upon a form furnished by the chairman of the board of directors of the Federal Reserve Bank of the district. Each such officer shall make a cross opposite the name of the first, second, and other choices for a director of Class A and for a director of Class B, but shall not vote more than one choice for any one candidate."

In the case of the Class A ballots (Group 3), where there are two candidates involved, a member bank, in making its first choice, will be deemed to have indicated the remaining candidate as its second choice.

CANDIDATES FOR CLASS A DIRECTOR (Listed Alphabetically)

Allan James "Jimmy" Rasmussen

President and Chief Executive Officer HomeTown Bank, N.A. Galveston, Texas

For the past 24 years, Rasmussen has served as president and CEO of HomeTown Bank, N.A., a community banking organization with \$440 million in assets headquartered in Galveston, Texas. He taught for one year as a full-time instructor in the Business Department at Sam Houston State University before accepting a position at American Bank in Huntsville, Texas, in March 1975. Rasmussen has also worked at what is now Texas First Bank in Texas City and opened a newly chartered bank there in 1982. He accepted a position at Bank of Galveston, N.A. in June 1988 and assumed the duties of president and CEO in January 1989. The name of the bank was changed to HomeTown Bank, N.A. in 1999 to accommodate new branches away from Galveston Island.

Rasmussen was chairman of the Texas City–LaMarque Chamber of Commerce and on the board of trustees of the Texas City Independent School District. He has served on the board of directors and executive committee of the Independent Bankers of Texas (IBAT) and as its chairman. He has also served as a Texas representative on the board of directors of the Independent Community Bankers of America (ICBA). Rasmussen has served on the board of directors and executive committee of the Galveston Chamber of Commerce and was the founding chairman of the Galveston Economic Development Partnership.

He received his BBA in 1973 and MBA in finance in 1974 from Sam Houston State University.

Ann B. Stern

President and Chief Executive Officer Houston Endowment

Stern is the president and CEO of Houston Endowment, a private foundation with more than \$1.5 billion in assets that was established by Jesse H. and Mary Gibbs Jones in 1937 to improve life for the people of greater Houston.

Stern is the former executive vice president for Texas Children's Hospital, a position she held from 2008–12. She was responsible for all pediatric inpatient clinical operations; the legal, internal audit and risk management functions; global health and international operations; research administration; and corporate governance. She oversaw the development of the Jan and Dan Duncan Neurological Research Institute, one of the first research institutes dedicated to pediatric neurodevelopmental disorders. She had responsibility for the hospital's expansion into high-risk obstetrics and gynecology, including the opening of the new Texas Children's Pavilion for Women. During this time, she served as a board member of the Baylor International Pediatric AIDS initiative (BIPAI), an organization that operates pediatric clinical centers of excellence in Romania and across Africa.

From 2003–09, Stern held various positions at Texas Children's, including senior vice president, general counsel and corporate compliance officer.

Prior to joining Texas Children's, Stern practiced law with the law firms of Andrews & Kurth and Beck, Redden, and Secrest. She also taught business law at the University of St. Thomas.

Stern currently serves as a director of the Houston Branch of the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas and as chairman of the board of St. John's School. Previously, she served on the Advisory Commission on Childhood Vaccines (U.S. Health Resources and Services Administration) and on the boards of Texas Children's Hospital and St. Luke's Episcopal Health Charities. She is a former president of the Junior League of Houston. She is a recipient of the Distinguished Alumnus Award for Community Service from the University of Texas School of Law.

She received both a BA and a JD from the University of Texas at Austin.
