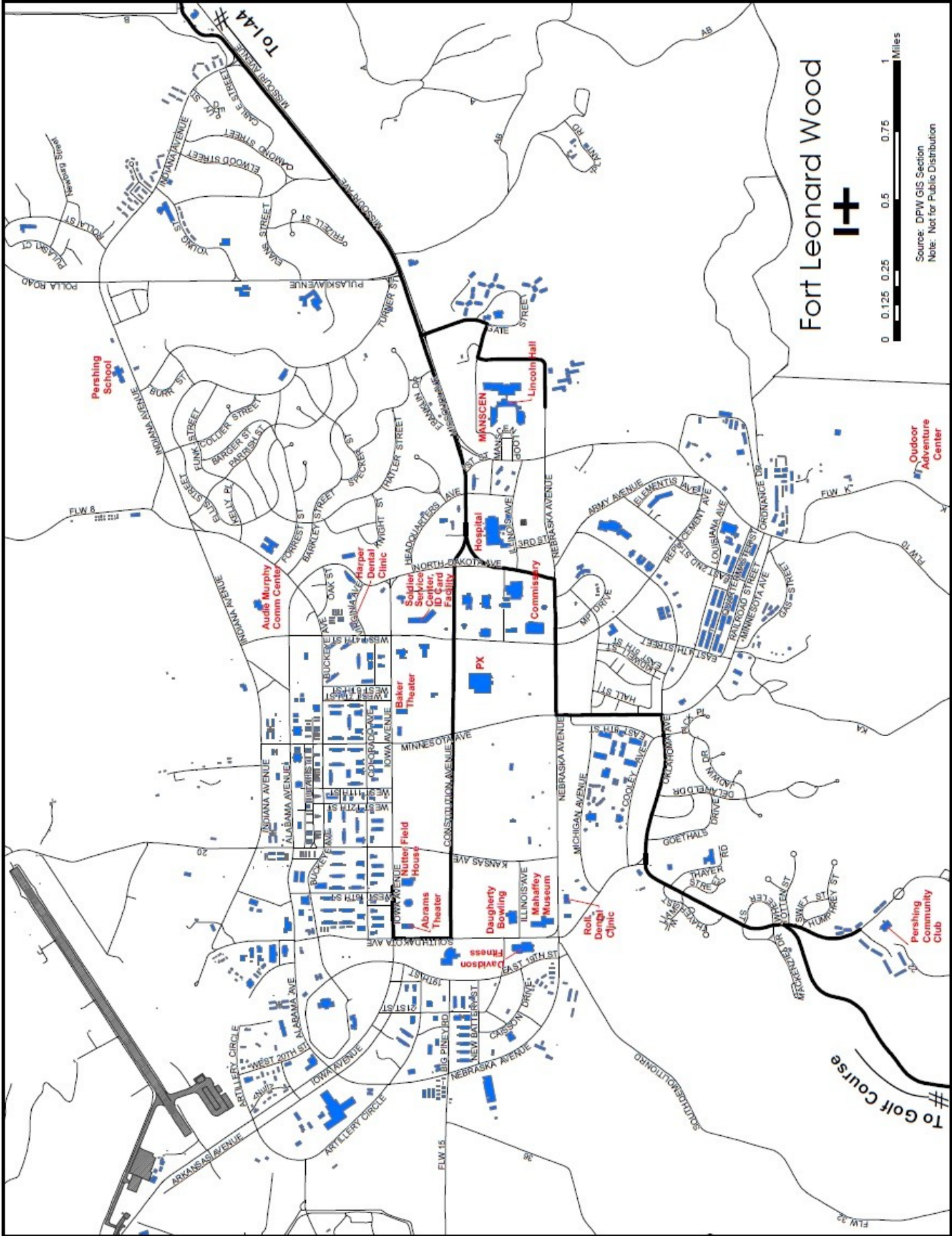

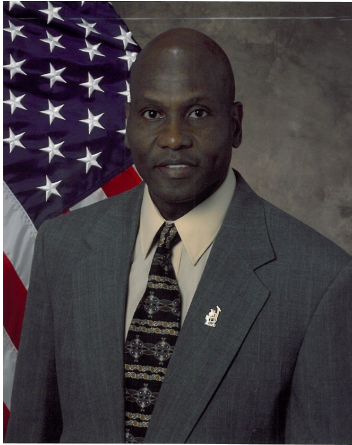

# RETIREE APPRECIATION DAYS SEPTEMBER 7, 8, 2012

CSM (RET) HAROLD LLOYD BURLERSON

FORT LEONARD WOOD RETIREE OF THE YEAR



CSM (Ret) Harold Burleson was drafted into the Army in February, 1971 and entered Basic Training at Fort Polk, Louisiana followed by his Military Police Advanced Individual Training (AIT) at Fort Gordon, Georgia. CSM (Ret) Burleson assignments include the 164<sup>th</sup> Military Police Company, Miesau, Germany; Military Police Investigator and Supervisor in Kaiserslautern and Zweibruecken, Germany; and Military Police Drill Sergeant, Ft McClellan, Alabama. CSM (Ret) Burleson was reassigned to Germany to the 529<sup>th</sup> Military Police Company as a Squad Leader and Platoon Sergeant position until his reassignment to Ft. McClellan, Alabama as a Military Police Weapons Instructor and Military Police Academy Company First Sergeant and Enlisted Company Commander. During his assignment at the NCO Academy Company, CSM (Ret) Burleson was selected for the Ser-

geants Major Academy. CSM (Ret) Burleson was reassigned at Ft McClellan to the Headquarters Battalion and 701<sup>st</sup> Military Police Battalion as the Command Sergeant Major. In June 1993, he was reassigned to Germany as the Command Sergeant Major, 95<sup>th</sup> Military Police Battalion and the 18<sup>th</sup> Military Police Brigade Command Sergeant Major followed by selection as the Sixth Military Police Corps Regimental Command Sergeant Major, United States Army Military Police School Sergeant Major, and Commandant, Military Police Non-commissioned Officers Academy. CSM (Ret) Burleson was a key participant instrumental in the transition of the Military Police School from Fort McClellan, Alabama to Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri in 1999. CSM (R) Burleson retired from 30 years of active military duty in February 2001. After his military retirement, he worked in the Ft. Leonard Wood Community and is now employed by the Maneuver Support Center of Excellence, Directorate for Counter Improvised Explosive Device, Capabilities Integration Division as an Accelerated Capabilities Development Analyst CSM (R) Burleson's awards and decorations include an induction into the Military Police Hall of Fame; nominee for the Waynesville-St Robert, Missouri Chamber of Commerce Citizen of the Year; and recognition for superior achievements and accomplishments from the Ft Leonard Wood Chapels and several civilian organizations. CSM (R) Burleson and his wife Brigitte have been married for 39 years and reside in St. Robert, Missouri.

## ID FACILITY

The Fort Leonard Wood Identification (ID) Card Facility located in building 470, has an appointment system for all customers on post and the surrounding community. All customers make their own appointments by logging onto the Web site, <https://rapids-appointments.dmdc.osd.mil/>. Individual appointments are required for each family member requiring an ID card. Customers without computer access may call the ID Card Facility for an appointment at 573-596-0744. Limited walk-ins are still being accepted. The ID Card Facility, building 470, room 2101, will be open on Saturday, September 8, 2012 from 1000-1200 for Retiree walk-



-ins. The following documents are needed to make the process of receiving an ID card easier: original or certified marriage certificate, birth certificate, divorce decree (if applicable), retirement orders or DD Form 214, and SSN card for all dependent children. ## JUDGE ADVOCATE GENERAL

The Fort Leonard Wood Legal Assistance Office is located at 316 Missouri Avenue, Building 315, Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. Will Briefs explaining wills, living wills, and health care powers of attorney are held weekly. Legal Assistance will offer to prepare and execute estate planning documents in one day after attending the will brief.

Items and information necessary to complete a will in one visit: (1) military ID card (2) Names, addresses, and phone numbers for your agents, executors and guardians, if applicable (3) List of personal property to be distributed (4) addresses for all real property (5) Other specified arrangements.

If you do not have all the required information, the personnel at legal assistance will ask that you take the questionnaire home for completion and return it to the office. 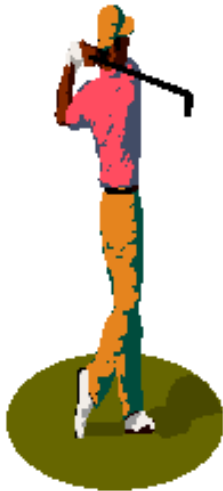
