










TSA's Summer Travel Checklist

Make Summer Travel a Breeze

-  Please get to the airport early to account for increased passenger loads.
-  Liquids, gels and aerosols as carry-ons must be in:
 - **3**-ounce or smaller containers placed in a
 - **1**-quart, clear, plastic, zip-top bag
 - **1** bag per passenger placed in a plastic bin for screening.Larger quantities must be placed in checked luggage.
-  Double check the contents of your pockets and carry-on baggage to ensure no prohibited items such as knives or firearms were inadvertently packed.
-  Firearms must be unloaded, placed in a locked, hard-sided container and properly declared to your airline.
-  All fireworks contain explosive materials and are not permitted in checked or carry-on baggage.
-  You are required to remove footwear for X-ray screening. Wearing footwear that can be easily removed helps speed you through the screening process.
-  Do not pack fragile or valuable items in checked baggage. Ship or take them with you in carry-on baggage.
-  Do not over-pack bags. Closing overstuffed bags can be difficult and may result in a checked bag being delayed.
-  Put undeveloped film in carry-on baggage. Checked baggage screening equipment may damage film.
